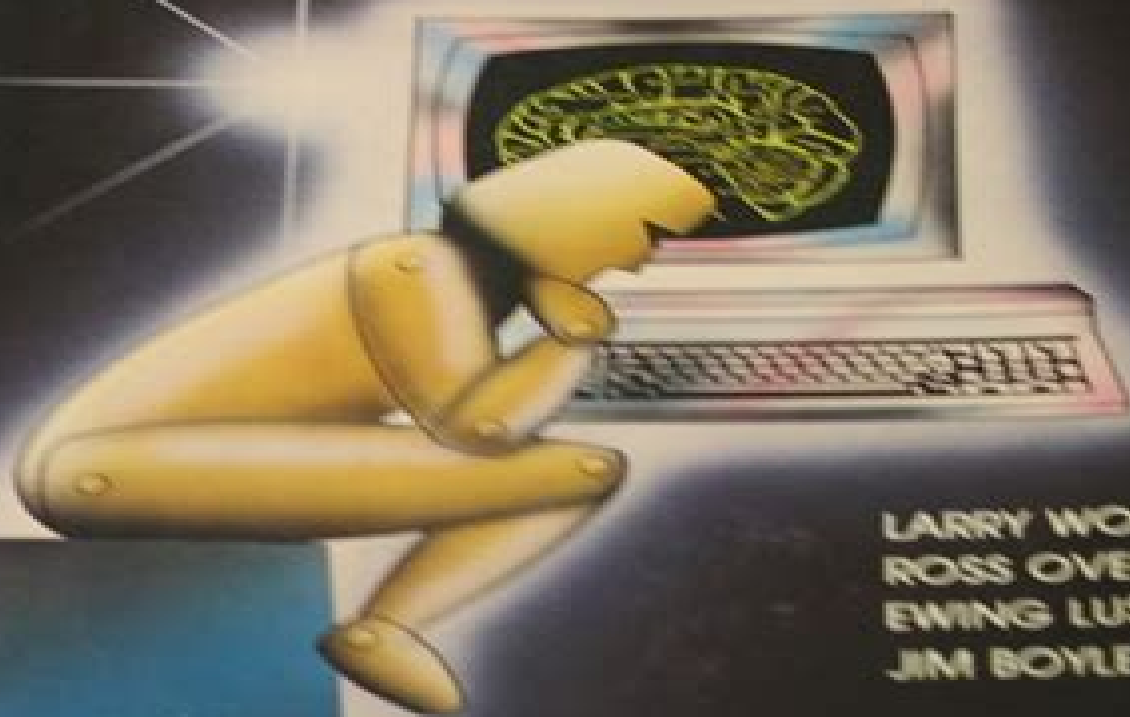

The Efficiency of Theorem Proving Strategies David A.

Plaisted, Yunshan Zhu, 2013-11-11 This is the second and slightly revised edition of this book A few errors have been fixed and some references to related work have been added I thank the readers for their comments on the first edition We analyze the search efficiency of a number of common refutational theorem proving strategies on propositional and near propositional problems Search efficiency is concerned with the total number of proofs and partial proofs generated rather than with the sizes of the proofs We show that most common strategies produce search spaces of exponential size even on simple sets of clauses or else are not sensitive to the goal However clause linking which uses a reduction to propositional calculus has behavior that is more favorable in some respects a property that it shares with methods that cache subgoals A strategy which is of interest for term rewriting based theorem proving is the A ordering strategy and we discuss it in some detail We show some advantages of A ordering over other strategies which may help to explain its efficiency in practice We also point out some of its combinatorial inefficiencies especially in relation to goal sensitivity and irrelevant clauses In addition SLD resolution which is of importance for Prolog implementation has combinatorial inefficiencies this may suggest basing Prolog implementations on a different theorem proving strategy We also develop techniques for studying the asymptotic complexity of first order theorem provers This permits an analytic comparison of the worst case performances of various theorem proving methods

Advanced Database Systems Peter M.D. Gray, 1992-06-24 The theme of this book is the potential of new advanced database systems The volume presents the proceedings of the 10th British National Conference on Databases held in Aberdeen Scotland in July 1992 The volume contains two invited papers one on the promise of distributed computing and the challenges of legacy systems by M L Brodie and the other on object oriented requirements capture and analysis and the Orca project by D J L Gradwell The following four parts each contain three submitted papers selected from a total of 36 submissions The parts are

entitled Object oriented databases Parallel implementations and industrial systems Non relational data models Logic programming and databases Mathematical Aspects of Artificial Intelligence Frederick Hoffman, American Mathematical Society, 1998 There exists a history of great expectations and large investments involving artificial intelligence AI There are also notable shortfalls and memorable disappointments One major controversy regarding AI is just how mathematical a field it is or should be This text includes contributions that examine the connections between AI and mathematics demonstrating the potential for mathematical applications and exposing some of the more mathematical areas within AI The goal is to stimulate interest in people who can contribute to the field or use its results Included in the work by M Newborn on the famous Deep Blue chess match He discusses highly mathematical techniques involving graph theory combinatorics and probability and statistics G Shafer offers his development of probability through probability trees with some of the results appearing here for the first time M Golumbic treats temporal reasoning with ties to the famous Frame Problem His contribution involves logic combinatorics and graph theory and leads to two chapters with logical themes H Kirchner explains how ordering techniques in automated reasoning systems make deduction more efficient Constraint logic programming is discussed by C Lassez who shows its intimate ties to linear programming with crucial theorems going back to Fourier V Nalwa's work provides a brief tour of computer vision tying it to mathematics from combinatorics probability and geometry to partial differential equations All authors are gifted expositors and are current contributors to the field The wide scope of the volume includes research problems research tools and good motivational material for teaching

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
