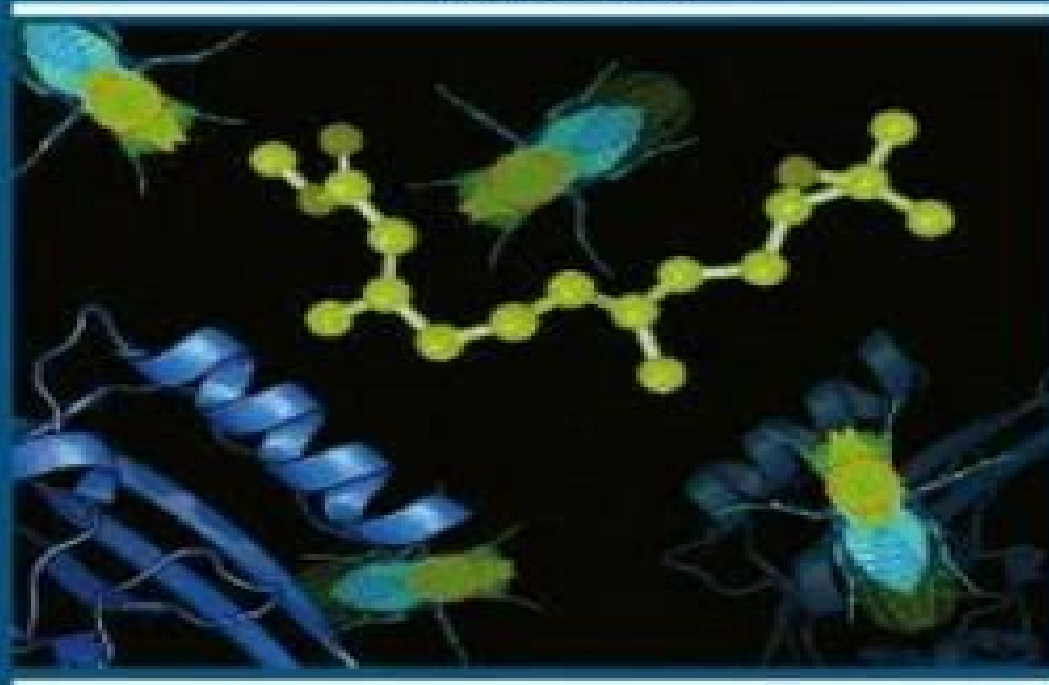


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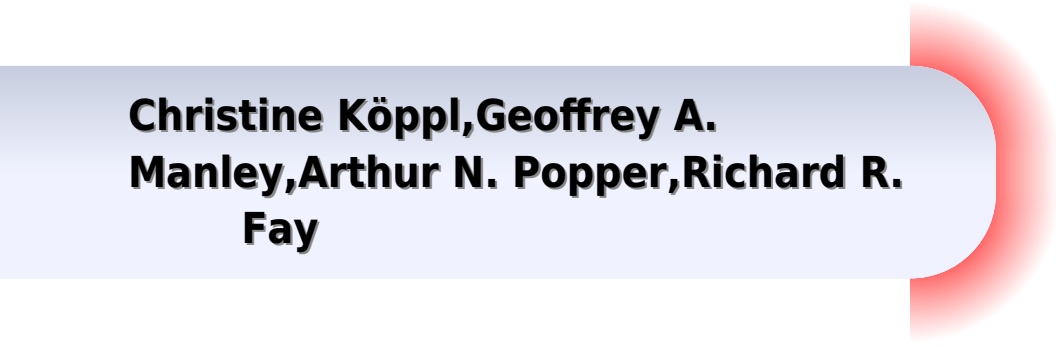

Mechanisms Underlying Microbial Symbiosis, 2020-05-27 Insects engage in intimate associations with microbial symbionts that colonize their digestive systems or internal cells and tissues. The stability and near ubiquity of many of these symbioses implies their importance, a prediction supported through experimentation. With the advancing power of experimental methodologies and the growing accessibility of genomic techniques, insect science has reached a powerful new stage, enabling the study of previously recalcitrant symbioses, including several with medical and agricultural significance. In this volume, we publish a collection of chapters focused on the physiology of insect-microbe symbioses, emphasizing their mechanistic underpinnings and the ecological and evolutionary causes and consequences of these interactions. Death-Feigning in Insects Masaki Sakai, 2021-03-30 This book examines the mechanisms and functions of tonic immobility, the so-called death feigning behavior, or thanatosis, or animal hypnosis. The chapters cover the neurophysiological and experimental studies on insects, the functional significance of death feigning, examination of the freezing and immobility behavior in insects through environment, physiology, genetics, and responses to ultrasound and vibration. It also covers tonic immobility and freezing behavior in fish from the perspective of vertebrates. Tonic immobility is an interesting behavior that occurs reflexively in various animals under physical restraint by predators. The physiological mechanism of thanatosis was extensively investigated during 1960-1980. Researchers have proposed hypotheses to explain the mechanism underlying tonic immobility in vertebrates: local inhibition of the central nervous system, acceleration of the limbic system, abnormal control of the autonomic nervous system. On the other hand, the peripheral and central mechanisms of tonic immobility were intensely

investigated at a behavioral and a neuronal level in stick insects and crickets In the 1970s behavioral ecology has shed light on the aspect of an ultimate factor for tonic immobility Ethologists and ecologists challenged this matter in the laboratory and natural habitats and have collected evidence for its functional roles using mainly insects such as beetles moths locusts More recently studies of tonic immobility in humans are drawing attention as clinicians are trying to explain the defencelessness of rape victims from the viewpoint of animal hypnosis This timely publication provides an understanding of the past and present research of the mechanisms and functions of tonic immobility This book is intended for researchers and undergraduate graduate students in the field of zoology including physiology ethology ecology and human behavior It will also appeal to the public audience who has an interest in animal behavior including human behavior

Insect Hearing Gerald S. Pollack, Andrew C. Mason, Arthur N Popper, Richard R Fay, 2016-06-06 Insect Hearing provides a broadly based view of the functions mechanisms and evolution of hearing in insects With a single exception the chapters focus on problems of hearing and their solutions rather than being focused on particular taxa The exception hearing in *Drosophila* is justified because due to its ever growing toolbox of genetic and optical techniques *Drosophila* is rapidly becoming one of the most important model systems in neurobiology including the neurobiology of hearing Auditory systems whether insectan or vertebrate must perform a number of basic tasks capturing mechanical stimuli and transducing these into neural activity representing the timing and frequency of sound signals distinguishing between behaviorally relevant signals and other sounds and localizing sound sources Studying how these are accomplished in insects offers a valuable comparative view that helps to reveal general principles of auditory function

Colorants for Non-Textile Applications H.S. Freeman, A.T. Peters, 2000-05-03 This volume examines the chemistry of natural and synthetic dyes produced for non textile markets where much new basic research in color chemistry is now taking place The first group of chapters covers the design synthesis properties and application technology pertaining to dyes for digital printing and photography The reader will be pleased with the breadth and depth of information presented in each case Of particular interest is the discussion of strategies for the design of dyes in these categories with emphasis on enhancing technical properties In view of certain new developments the ink jet chapter includes results from studies pertaining to dyes for textiles The three chapters comprising Section II of this volume cover the broad subject of dyes for food drug and cosmetic applications and then provide an in depth look at dyes for biomedical applications and molecular recognition The chapter on dyes for molecular recognition places emphasis on applications in the biological sciences including sensory materials and artificial receptors While the former two topics have been covered elsewhere in the past the present chapters are unequalled in scope Section III provides an in depth review of the design of laser dyes and dye based functional materials In the first of the two chapters the major principles of laser operation are summarized This is followed by a discussion of spectroscopic properties such as activation and deactivation of absorbed light by laser dyes Approaches to the development of new laser dyes are presented The second chapter pertains to

the synthesis of dicyanopyrazine based multifunctional dyes The visible and fluorescence spectra of these dyes in solution and the solid state are correlated with their three dimensional molecular structures Molecular stacking behavior and solid state properties of these multifunctional dye materials are presented The final group of chapters pertains to natural dyes and dyes for natural substrates In recent years the impression among certain consumers that natural is better safer has generated much interest in the use of natural dyes rather than synthetics This has led to a few short discussion papers in which the environmental advantages to using natural dyes have been questioned The initial chapter in this group provides both a historical look at natural dyes and a comprehensive compilation of natural dye structures and their sources Though natural dyes are of interest as colorants for textiles selected ones are used primarily in food and cosmetics Chapter ten provides an update on the author s previous reviews of structure color relationships among precursors employed in the coloration of hair Chemical constitutions characterizing hair dye structures are presented along with a summary of available precursors and their environmental properties Similarly the chapter on leather dyes covers constitutions and nomenclature in addition to providing interesting perspectives on the origin and use of leather the dyeing of leather and key environmental issues This volume is concluded with another look at colors in nature In this case rather than revisiting colors in plant life an interesting chapter dealing with color in the absence of colorants is presented Chapter twelve covers basic concepts of color science and illustrates how 3 D assemblies leading to a plethora of colors are handled in nature It is our hope that this atypical color chemistry chapter will invoke ideas that lead to the design of useful colorants The chapters presented in this volume demonstrate that color chemistry still has much to offer individuals with inquiring minds who are searching for a career path This work highlights the creativity of today s color chemists and the wide variety of interesting non textile areas from which a career can be launched

Raabe,2012-12-06 The most striking fact revealed by investigations of insect neurohormones is that insects are as well supplied with neurohormones as mammals since neurohormones regulate not only the functioning of the endocrine glands prothoracic gland and corpora allata but also most physiological processes Our knowledge of neurohormones developed originally from anatomocytological investigations and experimental studies Today accurate bio assays have been devised for studying both in vivo and in vitro physiological processes and RIA determination has yielded knowledge of titer modifications of humoral factors Much is also known about neurohormone purification and several neurohormones have even been identified in different species Immunocytochemistry has made it possible to demonstrate in their origin and release sites the presence of insect neurohormones whose structure has been elucidated Moreover the presence of vertebrate and invertebrate neuropeptides has been demonstrated in insects As regards biogenic amines methods of detection have been greatly refined and it is now possible to identify the cell bodies and axons of the main biogenic amines Other new methods such as cobalt chloride impregnation or Lucifer yellow staining have revealed the axonal pathways and the location of particular neurons The mechanisms of action of neurohormones have been investigated in several cases and the results of these investigations will be related in the chapters which follow Biorational Control of Arthropod Pests Isaac Ishaaya,A.

Rami Horowitz,2009-08-28 For nearly 50 years pest control was mostly based on broad spectrum conventional insecticides such as organochlorines organophosphates carbamates and pyrethroids However the severe adverse effects of pesticides on the environment problems of resistance reaching crisis proportions and public protests led to stricter regulations and legislation aimed at reducing their use Ways to reduce the use of synthetic pesticides in plant protection and to use more alternative and novel methods for pest control or biorational control are the challenges of pest control for the twenty first century The term biorational biological rational pesticides can be defined as the use of specific and selective chemicals often with a unique modes of action that are compatible with natural enemies and the environment with minimal effect on n target organisms Biorational control is based on a diversity of chemical biological and physical approaches for controlling insect pests which results in minimum risk to man and the environment

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
