Describe treatments for PTSD and how they work.

★ Biological Treatments

- **SSRIs:** mixed efficacy, high relapse rate
- **Benzos:** spotty efficacy, safety behaviors

★ Psychological Treatments

- Efficacious CBT adaptations

■ Prolonged exposure

- Patients are asked to write or audio record narratives of the trauma
 - They focus on the worst trauma that the patient has experienced if there are multiple or the one that has impacted most
- Repeatedly confront the trauma by reading or listening to the narrative they wrote or recorded
- Exposure to avoided places or people via VR (virtual reality) or recreated setting like (Hollywood sets)

■ Cognitive processing therapy

- This is where you process what has happened along side a trained professional
- There is a 40-60% improvement rate with this
- CBT based therapy for PTSD
- Have patients write a narrative of the impact of the trauma on their lives at beginning of treatment
- Bulk of the treatment is on identifying and challenging distorted thoughts, which are also called **stuck** points.
 - The patient revisits and rewrites narrative following treatment
 - This should be done as many times as necessary
- Thinking about the trauma should cease to lead to heightened reactivity because it should become more boring to think about because all aspects of trauma have been processed thoroughly.

★ Psychological maintaining factors

- Cognitive factors

- Dysfunctional beliefs: self, others, or world
- Distorted attributions of blame
