formula $d = \sqrt{(x_2 - x_1)^2 + (y_2 - y_1)^2}$ label the points $x_1, y_1 = 5, 3$ $x_2, y_2 = 7, 2$ and substitute $d = \sqrt{(7 - 5)^2 + (2 - 3)^2}$ simplify $d = \sqrt{2^2 + (-1)^2} = \sqrt{4 + 1} = \sqrt{5}$
