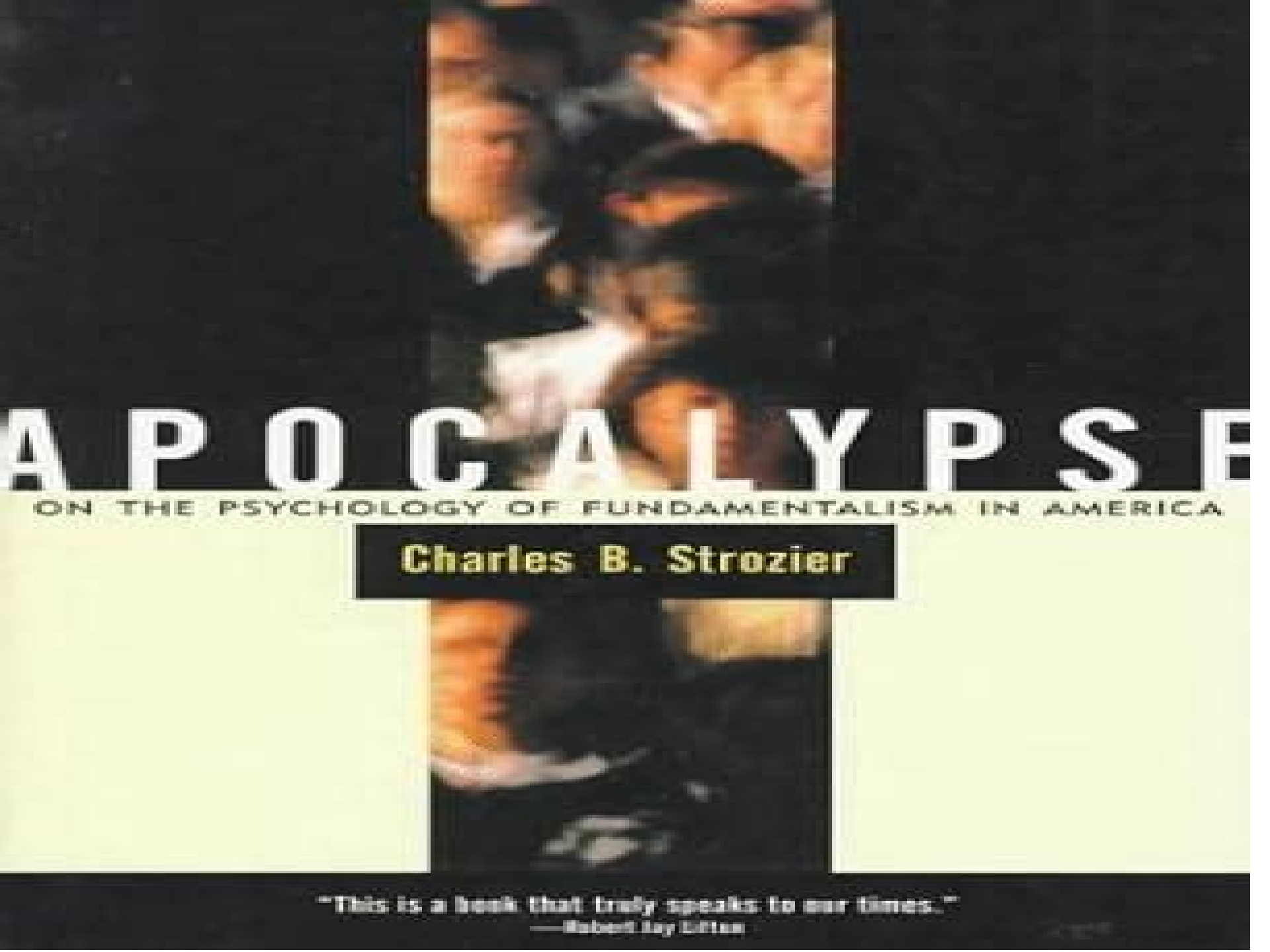

Strozier, 2002-09-09 By some estimates as many as fifty million Americans believe that the Apocalypse when God will remake the world Jesus will return to rule and only the faithful will survive is near In Apocalypse psychoanalyst and historian Charles B Strozier offers a rare and intimate look at the inner lives of such believers through a study of fundamentalist Christians in New York City today *The Oxford Handbook of Apocalyptic Literature* John Joseph Collins, 2014 Apocalypticism arose in ancient Judaism in the last centuries BCE and played a crucial role in the rise of Christianity It is not only of historical interest there has been a growing awareness especially since the 2001 terrorist attacks on the United States of the prevalence of apocalyptic beliefs in the contemporary world To understand these beliefs it is necessary to appreciate their complex roots in the ancient world and the multi faceted character of the phenomenon of apocalypticism The *Oxford Handbook of Apocalyptic Literature* is a thematic and phenomenological exploration of apocalypticism in the Judaic and Christian traditions Most of the volume is devoted to the apocalyptic literature of antiquity Essays explore the relationship between apocalypticism and prophecy wisdom and mysticism the social function of apocalypticism and its role as resistance literature apocalyptic rhetoric from both historical and postmodern perspectives and apocalyptic theology focusing on phenomena of determinism and dualism and exploring apocalyptic theology s role in ancient Judaism early Christianity and Gnosticism The final chapters of the volume are devoted to the appropriation of apocalypticism in the modern world reviewing the role of apocalypticism in contemporary Judaism and Christianity and more broadly in popular culture addressing the increasingly studied relation between apocalypticism and violence and discussing the relationship between apocalypticism and trauma which speaks to the underlying causes of the popularity of apocalyptic beliefs This volume will further the understanding of a vital religious phenomenon too often dismissed as alien and irrational by secular western society **The ^AOxford Handbook of Religion, Conflict, and Peacebuilding** Atalia Omer, R. Naming the Antichrist Robert C. Fuller, 1996-11-21 The Antichrist though mentioned a mere four times in the Bible and then only obscurely has exercised a tight hold on popular imagination throughout history This has been particularly true in the U S says author Robert C Fuller where Americans have tended to view our nation as uniquely blessed by God a belief that leaves us especially prone to demonizing our enemies In *Naming the Antichrist* Fuller takes us on a fascinating journey through the dark side of the American religious psyche from the earliest American colonists right up to contemporary fundamentalists such as Pat Robertson and Hal Lindsey Fuller begins by offering a brief history of the idea of the Antichrist and its origins in the apocalyptic thought in the Judeo Christian tradition and traces the eventual 71 Gws how the colonists saw Antichrist personified in native Americans and French Catholics in Anne Hutchinson Roger Williams and the witches of Salem in the Church of England and the King He looks at the Second Great Awakening in the early nineteenth century showing how such prominent Americans as Yale president

Timothy Dwight and the Reverend Jedidiah Morse father of Samuel Morse saw the work of the Antichrist in phenomena ranging from the French Revolution to Masonry In the twentieth century he finds a startling array of hate mongers from Gerald Winrod who vilified Roosevelt as a pawn of the Antichrist to the Ku Klux Klan who drew on apocalyptic imagery in their attacks on Jews Catholics blacks socialists and others Finally Fuller considers contemporary fundamentalist writers such as Hal Lindsey author of *The Late Great Planet Earth* with some 19 million copies sold Mary Stewart Relfe whose candidates for the Antichrist have included such figures as Henry Kissinger Pope John Paul II and Anwar Sadat and a host of others who have found Antichrist in the sinister guise of the European Economic Community the National Council of Churches feminism New Age religions and even supermarket barcodes and fibre optics the latter functioning as the eye of the Antichrist Throughout Fuller reveals in vivid detail how our unique American obsession with the Antichrist reflects the struggle to understand ourselves and our enemies within the mythic context of the battle of absolute good versus absolute evil From the Scofield Reference Bible no other book had greater impact on the American Antichrist tradition to the Scopes Monkey Trial Fuller provides an informative and often startling look at a thread that weaves persistently throughout American religious and cultural life

Territories of Evil ,2008-01-01 Evil is not only an abstract concept to be analyzed intellectually but a concrete reality that we all experience and wrestle with on an ongoing basis To truly understand evil we must always approach it from both angles the intellective and the phenomenological This same assertion resounds through each of the papers in this volume in which an interdisciplinary and international group including nurses psychologists philosophers professors of literature history computer studies and all sorts of social science presented papers on cannibalism the Holocaust terrorism physical and emotional abuse virtual and actual violence and depravity in a variety of media from film to literature to anim to the Internet Conference participants discussed villains and victims dictators and anti heroes from 921 AD to the present and considered the future of evil from a number of theoretical perspectives Personal encounters with evil were described and analyzed from interviews with political leaders to the problems of locating and destroying land mines in previous war zones

The theme of responsibility and thinking for the future is very much at the heart of these papers how to approach evil as a question to be explored critiqued interrogated reflected upon owned The authors urge an attitude of openness to new interpretations new perspectives new understanding This may not be a comfortable process it may in fact be quite disturbing But ultimately it may be the only way forward towards a truly ethical response The papers in this collection provide a wealth of food for thought on this most important question

Death's Dream Kingdom Walter A. Davis, 2006-03-20 Why is fear a dominant emotion in contemporary society Why are politicians using words like terror evil and fundamentalism and what effect is it having on public consciousness This book taps into the cultural psyche to explore the link between ideology and emotional and psychological manipulation It shows that the Bush administration has been hugely successful in controlling and developing a new political climate through the creation of an almost hypnotic mass consciousness From the sado masochist hysteria of Mel Gibson's *The Passion of the Christ* to the atrocities at Abu Ghraib prison and from the genocidal use of depleted uranium in Iraq to the apocalyptic language driving the Christian Right's assault on basic human rights Davis's findings take us to the heart of the ideological paralysis of the Left while offering an innovative approach to understanding contemporary history

Jones, 2014-02-04 Religion has been responsible for both horrific acts against humanity and some of humanity's most sublime teachings and experiences How is this possible From a contemporary psychoanalytic perspective this book seeks to answer that question in terms of the psychological dynamic of idealisation At the heart of living religion is the idealisation of everyday objects Such idealisations provide much of the transforming power of religious experience which is one of the positive contributions of religion to the psychological life However idealisation can also lead to religious fanaticism which can be very destructive Drawing on the work of various contemporary relational theorists within psychoanalysis this book develops a psychoanalytically informed theory of the transforming and terror producing effects of religious experience It discusses the question of whether or not if idealisation is the cause of many of the destructive acts done in the name of religion there can be vital religion without idealisation This is the first book to address the nature of religion and its capacity to sponsor both terrorism and transformation in terms of contemporary relational psychoanalytic theory It will be invaluable to students and practitioners of psychoanalysis psychotherapy psychology and religious studies and to others interested in the role of religion in the lives of individuals and societies

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
