Introduction

- What are viruses? (Non-living infectious agents that require a host cell to replicate)
- Why are viruses considered non-living? (Lack of independent metabolism and reproduction)
- General characteristics of viruses (Small size, simple structure, diverse shapes)

Virus Structure

- Genetic material (DNA or RNA)
- Capsid (Protein coat that protects the genetic material)
- Envelope (Lipid membrane surrounding some viruses)
- Viral proteins (Enzymes, surface proteins for attachment)

Viral Replication

- Lytic cycle (Virus replicates and destroys the host cell)
- Lysogenic cycle (Viral DNA integrates into the host cell's DNA)
- Steps of viral replication (Attachment, entry, replication, assembly, release)

Types of Viruses

- Classification based on genetic material (DNA viruses, RNA viruses)
- Classification based on shape (Helical, Icosahedral, complex)
- Examples of specific viruses (Influenza, HIV, Herpes simplex, bacteriophages)

Viral Diseases

- Common human viral diseases (Flu, common cold, chickenpox, measles, HIV/AIDS)
- Transmission of viral diseases (Airborne, direct contact, bodily fluids, vectors)
- Symptoms of viral infections (Fever, fatigue, cough, sore throat, rash)

Host Response to Viral Infections

- Immune system (Innate and adaptive immunity)
- Antibodies (Proteins that neutralize viruses)
- T cells (Cells that destroy infected cells)

Prevention and Treatment of Viral Infections

- Vaccines (Stimulate the immune system to produce antibodies)
