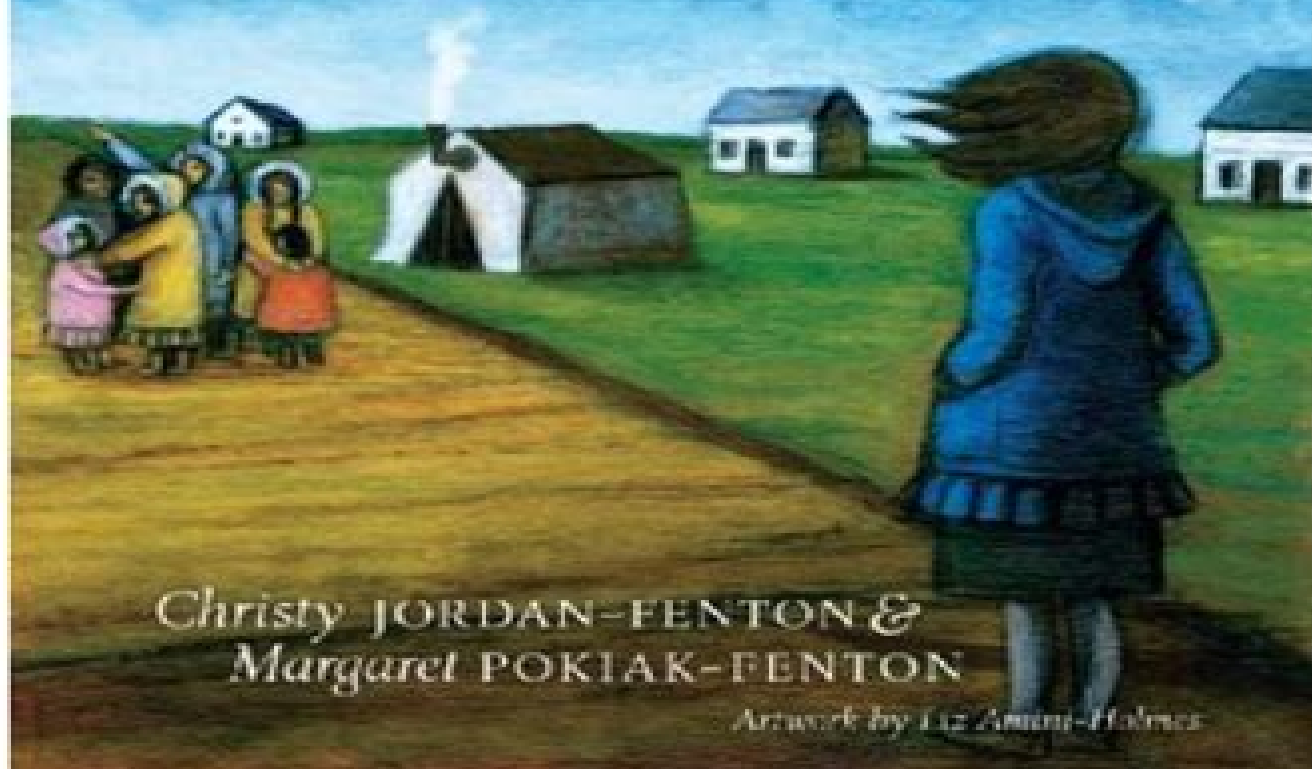

A Stranger At Home Christy Jordan-Fenton, Margaret-Olemaun Pokiak-Fenton, 2011-09-01 Margaret can't wait to see her family but her homecoming is not what she expected. Traveling to be reunited with her family in the arctic, 10-year-old Margaret Pokiak can hardly contain her excitement. It's been two years since her parents delivered her to the school run by the dark-cloaked nuns and brothers. Coming ashore, Margaret spots her family but her mother barely recognizes her, screaming "Not my girl." Margaret realizes she is now marked as an outsider. And Margaret is an outsider; she has forgotten the language and stories of her people and she can't even stomach the food her mother prepares. However, Margaret gradually relearns her language and her family's way of living. Along the way, she discovers how important it is to remain true to the ways of her people and to herself. Highlighted by archival photos and striking artwork, this first-person account of a young girl's struggle to find her place will inspire young readers to ask what it means to belong. *Strangers at Home* Yew-Foong Hui, 2011-09-09 Focusing on the historical experiences of Chinese from West Kalimantan, Indonesia, whether in terms of migratory trajectories or ethnic and state violence, this book interrogates the role of history in the formation of the Chinese Diasporic subject.

Reading the World's Stories Annette Y. Goldsmith, Theo Heras, Susan Corapi, 2016-08-11 *Reading the World's Stories* is volume 5 in the *Bridges to Understanding* series of annotated international youth literature bibliographies sponsored by the United States Board on Books for Young People (USBBY). The USBBY is the United States chapter of the International Board on Books for Young People (IBBY), a Switzerland-based nonprofit whose mission is to bring books and children together. The series promotes sharing international children's books as a way to facilitate intercultural understanding and meet new literary voices. This volume follows *Children's Books from Other Countries* (1998), *The World through Children's Books* (2002), *Crossing Boundaries with Children's Books* (2006), and *Bridges to Understanding: Envisioning the World through Children's Books* (2011) and acts as a companion book to the earlier titles. Centered around the theme of the importance of stories, the guide is a resource for discovering more recent global books that fit many reading tastes and educational needs for readers aged 0-18 years. Essays by storyteller Anne Pellowski, author Beverley Naidoo, and academic Marianne Martens offer a variety of perspectives on international youth literature. This latest installment in the series covers books published from 2010-2014 and includes English language imports as well as translations of children's and young adult literature first published outside of the United States. These books are supplemented by a smaller number of culturally appropriate books from the US to help fill in gaps from underrepresented countries. The organization of the guide is geographic by region and country. All of the more than 800 entries are recommended, and many of the books have won awards or achieved other recognition in their home countries. Forty children's book experts wrote the annotations. The entries are indexed by author, translator, illustrator, title, and subject. Back matter also includes international book awards, important organizations, and research collections, and a selected directory of publishers known for publishing books from other countries.

Teaching Social Justice Using

Postcolonial Texts Geraldine Balzer, Teresa Strong-Wilson, Anne Burke, 2023-07-28 This book explores how teachers can re-examine their emotional investments in enacting dominant settler values through changing their text selection and teaching practices. Based on a longitudinal qualitative research study conducted by a national team of literacy scholars in collaboration with practicing literacy teachers at eight sites across Canada, the book investigates how groups of teachers working collaboratively in inquiry groups develop and implement curriculum to promote their own and their students' understandings of social justice in postcolonial and settler spaces. In particular, the book highlights the rich and dynamic landscape of postcolonial authors, illustrators, and texts; the development of culturally sensitive curricula; and critical pedagogies possible in addressing contemporary and historical issues, both local and global. This book is primarily of interest to literacy scholars, literacy instructors, teacher educators in teacher education programs, educational leaders, practicing teachers from the K-12 spectrum, and school district staff and policy makers with responsibilities for or interests in the potential of literacy and literature engagement for social justice education. The book is also of interest to postsecondary educators and teacher educators wishing to use literature in social justice, anti-racist, and anti-oppressive courses.

A Stranger's Journey David Mura, 2018-08-01 Long recognized as a master teacher at writing programs like VONA, the Loft, and the Stonecoast MFA with *A Stranger's Journey*, David Mura has written a book on creative writing that addresses our increasingly diverse American literature. Mura argues for a more inclusive and expansive definition of craft, particularly in relationship to race, even as he elucidates timeless rules of narrative construction in fiction and memoir. His essays offer technique-focused readings of writers such as James Baldwin, ZZ Packer, Maxine Hong Kingston, Mary Karr, and Garrett Hongo while making compelling connections to Mura's own life and work as a Japanese American writer. In *A Stranger's Journey*, Mura poses two central questions: The first involves identity: How is writing an exploration of who one is and one's place in the world? Mura examines how the myriad identities in our changing contemporary canon have led to new challenges regarding both craft and pedagogy. Here, like Toni Morrison's *Playing in the Dark* or Jeff Chang's *Who We Be*, *A Stranger's Journey* breaks new ground in our understanding of the relationship between the issues of race, literature, and culture. The book's second central question involves structure: How does one tell a story? Mura provides clear, insightful narrative tools that any writer may use, taking in techniques from fiction, screenplays, playwriting, and myth. Through this process, Mura candidly explores the newly evolved aesthetic principles of memoir and how questions of identity occupy a central place in contemporary memoir.

Contemporary Canadian Picture Books Beverley Brenna, Richard Dionne, Theresa Tavares, 2021-05-31 This enriched reference guide offers a unique overview of more than 200 picture books published by Canadian publishing houses between 2017-2019. The authors cover key themes in contemporary Canadian titles that match broad curriculum trends in education. Response activities are included in the text, for example, frameworks for critical literacy discussions along with annotated bibliographies that specifically recognize titles by Indigenous authors and illustrators. The book also contains original

interviews with a dozen rising stars in Canadian writing and book illustration While the book is specifically geared for educators it also supports public libraries Education researchers and future picture book creators as well as families who are interested in learning more about reading development and related literacy activities for the home setting

Melville-Ross, 2016-06-02 Two for Joy is the heart warming true story of disabled twins Thomas and Alice and their desperate fight for life after being born four months prematurely James Melville Ross their father tells of how the twins not only survived despite being given the last rites as babies but also thrived From the dramatic first few months of the twins lives when Alice suffered a heart attack when only a day old and Thomas's lungs filled with blood leaving him only twenty minutes away from death Two for Joy reveals the path that James and his wife Georgie have followed as parents to two severely disabled children After the initial anger came the sheer hard work the sleepless nights the hospital dashes the curious stares and unwelcome comment from strangers But slowly came acceptance and eventually celebration of the joy that the medical marvels Thomas and Alice now happy and energetic ten year olds have brought to their lives Finally they understood that disability might have turned their world upside down but that it has also provided rewards beyond anything they could have imagined This story is for any parent experiencing the shock of having extremely premature babies or coming to terms with having a child diagnosed with a disability More than that this story will change people's attitudes to disability and show that love and true happiness can be found in even the most challenging of circumstances
