Chapter seven covers white collar criminology and given that most of the pioneer criminologists mainly focused on street crime the chapter looks at white collar crime which is even more harmful Chapter eight focuses on penology which is the study of punishment and the treatment of offenders. It covers areas such as theories of punishment forms of punishment the death penalty restorative justice and recidivism Lastly chapter nine focuses on crime control and prevention. The chapter starts by looking at two models of the criminal justice process the crime control model and the due process model. The bulk of the chapter then looks at crime prevention which entails any action designed to reduce the actual level of crime and or the perceived fear of crime Among others the chapter looks at crime prevention through environmental design situational crime prevention crime prevention through social development as well as various policing strategies for crime prevention
