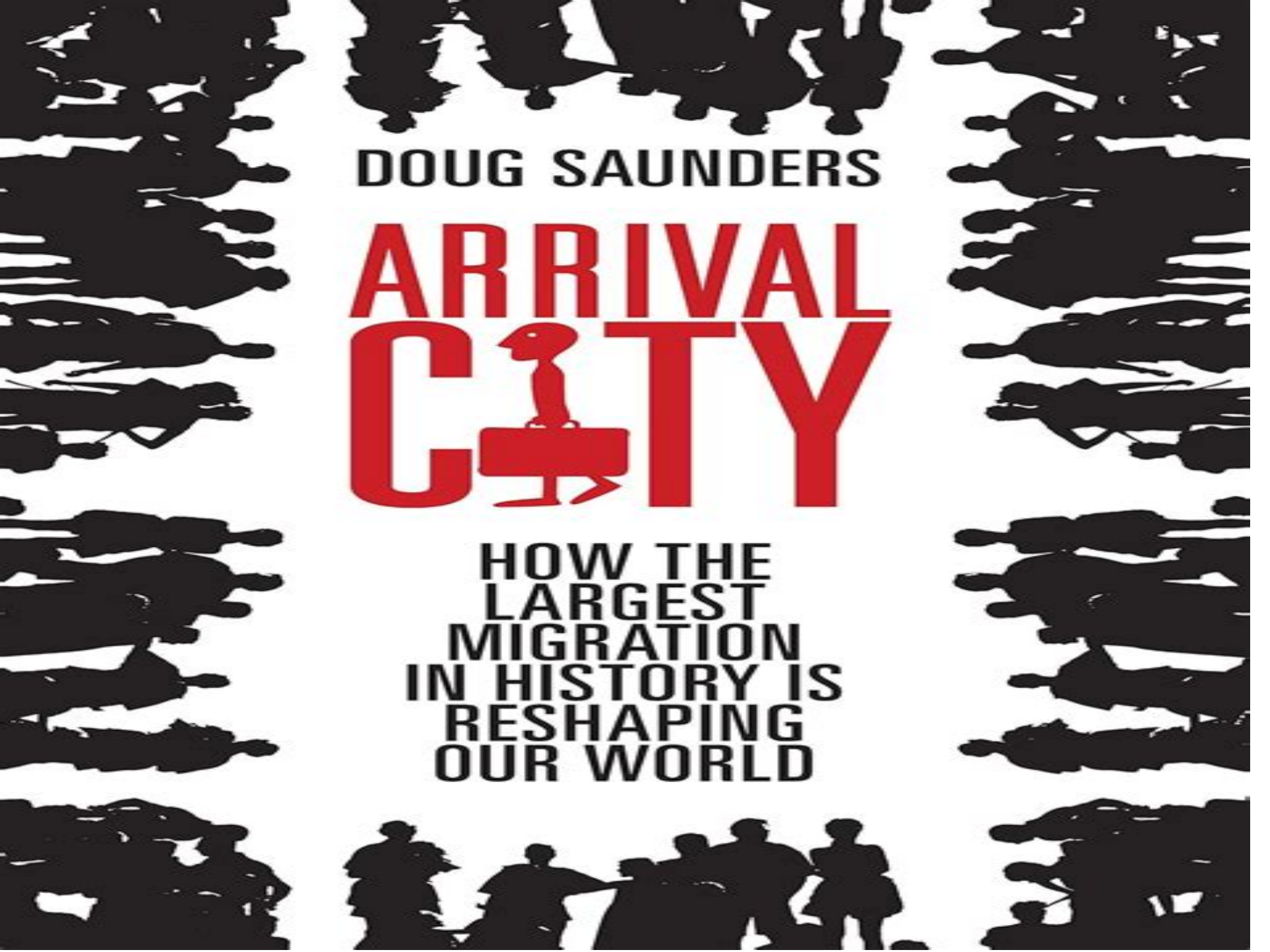

The arrival city exists on the outskirts of the metropolis, in the slums or in the suburbs. The American version is New York's Lower East Side of a century ago or today's Herndon County, Virginia. Their goal is to build communities to save and invest and hopefully move out, making room for the next wave of migrants. For some, success is years away; for others, it will never come at all. As vibrant places of exchange, arrival cities have long been indicators of social health. But as the award-winning journalist Doug Saunders demonstrates, when we make proper investments in our arrival cities through transportation, education, security, and citizenship, a prosperous middle class develops.
