Bonhoeffer the Assassin? Mark Thiessen Nation, Anthony G. Siegrist, Daniel P. Umbel, 2013-10-01 Most of us think we know the moving story of Dietrich Bonhoeffer's life a pacifist pastor turns anti Hitler conspirator due to horrors encountered during World War II but does the evidence really support this prevailing view This pioneering work carefully examines the biographical and textual evidence and finds no support for the theory that Bonhoeffer abandoned his ethic of discipleship and was involved in plots to assassinate Hitler In fact Bonhoeffer consistently affirmed a strong stance of peacemaking from 1932 to the end of his life and his commitment to peace was integrated with his theology as a whole The book includes a foreword Christian Martyrdom and Christian Violence Matthew D.
