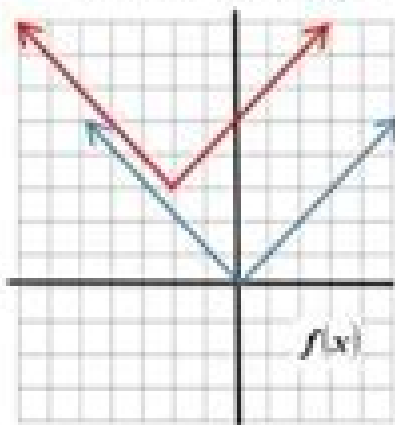


Transformations of Absolute Value Function

$$f(x) = |x + h| + k$$

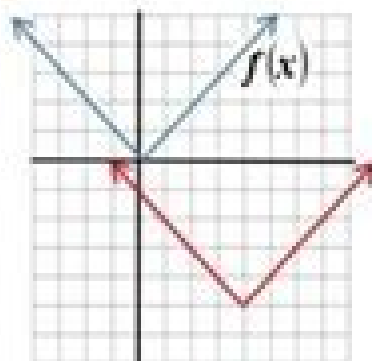
1. Graph

$$f(x) = |x - h| - k$$

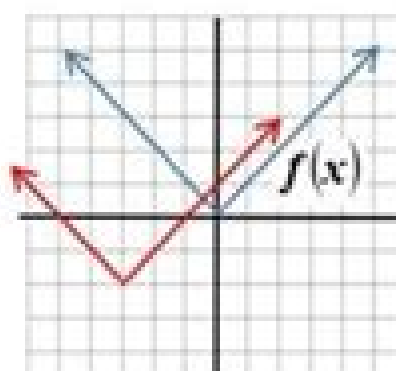
2. Graph

& Vertical shift down 5



Write the function:
 $f(x) = |x - 4| - 5$

$$f(x) = |x + h| - k$$

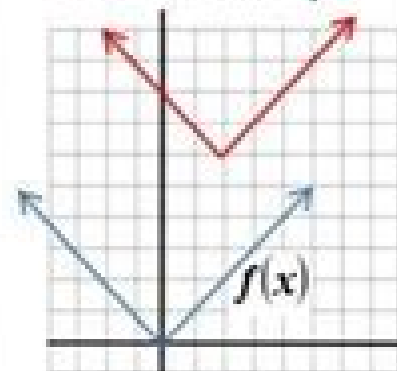
3. Graph
Horizontal shift left 3
& Vertical shift down 2



Write the function:
 $f(x) = |x + 3| - 2$

$$f(x) = |x - h| + k$$

4. Graph
Horizontal shift right 2
& Vertical shift up 6



Write the function:
 $f(x) = |x - 2| + 6$

$$f(x) = a|x + h| + k$$

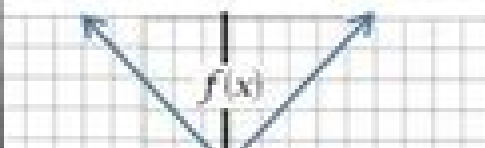
$$|a| > 1$$

Vertical compression by a factor of 2, horizontal shift left 3, vertical shift up 4



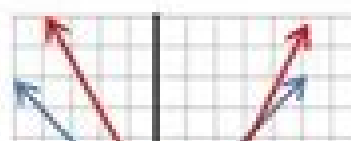
$$f(x) = |ax - h| - k$$

Vertical stretch by a factor of 1/3, horizontal shift right 3, vertical shift down 5



$$f(x) = |ax - h| - k$$

Horizontal compression by a factor of 2, horizontal shift right 2 units, vertical shift down 1 unit.



$$f(x) = -a|x + h| + k$$

Reflection over the x-axis, vertical stretch by a factor of 2, horizontal shift left 3 units, vertical shift up 4 units.
