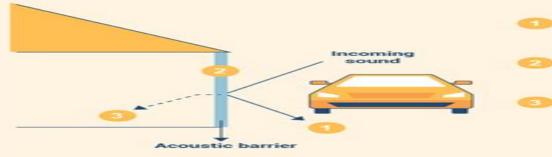

A building is designed to control sound, by amplifying or reducing noise levels where necessary.

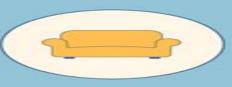
# **HOW SOUND TRAVELS**



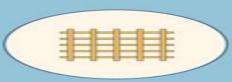
- Sound hits a surface and bounces back off of it.
- Sound hits a surface and some of it is absorbed.
  - Sound that isn't absorbed or reflected passes through the material, such as a wall.

## WHAT IMPACTS SOUND ABSORPTION?

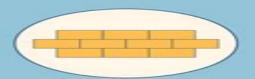
### MATERIALS



Soft and porous materials absorb more sound.



Fiberglass absorbs the most sound.



Concrete absorbs the least sound.

#### OTHER FACTORS



Higher levels of humidity result in more sound absorption.



Denser structures absorb higher sound frequencies than less dense structures.
