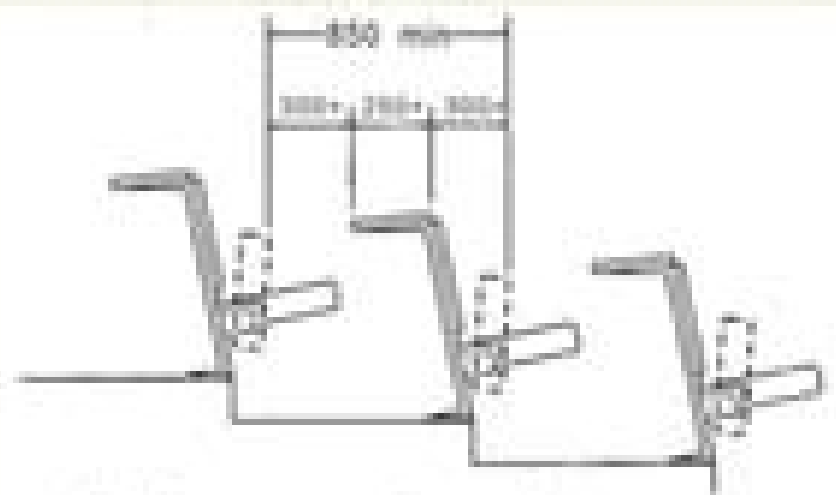
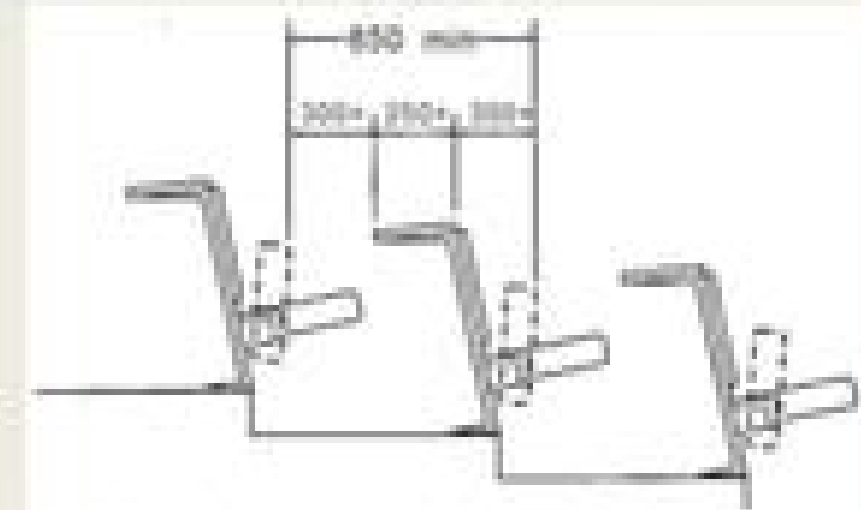


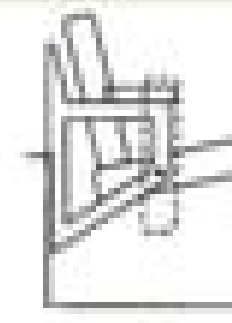
Design of the auditorium seat



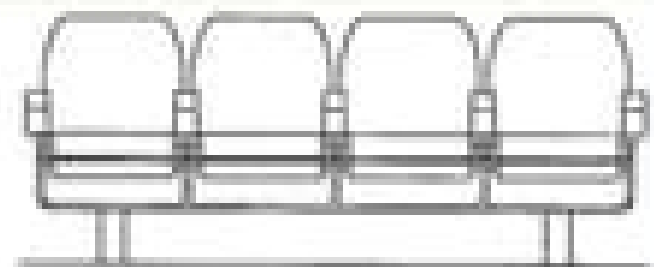
Fixed writing surface and tip-up seat.



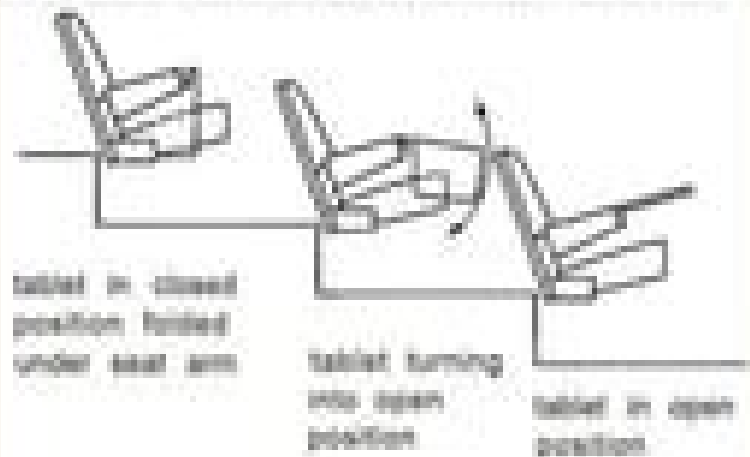
Fixed writing surface and tip-up seat.
