## Battery Installation

Remove the battery cover from the back of the computer using a flat blade screwdriver. Insert the battery with the positive (+) side facing the battery cover and replace the cover.

Should the LCD show irregular figures, take up the battery and start again. This will reset and restart the computer's microprocessor.



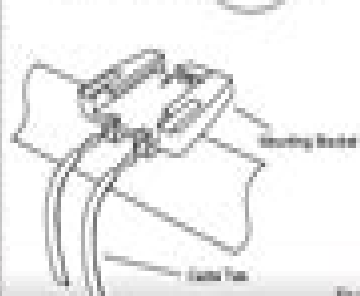

## Speedometer Sensor & Magnet

Slide the magnet between the spokes on the front wheel as shown in Fig. 1. Slide the speedometer sensor on the fork of front wheel by using the cable tie and making sure the wire of magnet is inside the aligned hole of the sensor as shown in Fig. 2 with free clearance as shown in Fig. 3.

## Sensor Wiring

Route the sensor wire up the fork inside, using the strap to secure it at the bottom and shown. Make sure not being loose. Leaving enough slack to allow free movement of the front wheel. Route the remaining wire around the front wheel spoke and to the handlebar. Secure wire should be tightly secured and secured to the stem with a tie strap.

## KM / MILE Selection

Selection of mode of measurement is presented right after the wheel size input. Then the unit you want to use will be shown. Press the function button 20" to choose between km and mile. The unit is then selected in speed mode and is ready for use.

## Auto Start / Stop

To preserve batteries, the cycle computer will automatically switch off if the unit is left unused for over 10 to 15 minutes. Once you measure with a push of start button or input from the sensor, it will be ready for use.

## Speed Computer (Distance)

A "1" or "1" sign appears to the right of the speed. "1" indicates you are traveling faster than your average speed. "1" indicates you are traveling slower than your average speed.



## Speed Tendency (Acceleration & Deceleration)

A right arrow appears to the left of the speed. The arrow turns forward "1" indicates you are traveling accelerating. The arrow turns backward "1" indicates you are traveling decelerating.



## Speedometer

Instantaneous speed is indicated on the LCD. The large digit measurement is from 0 to 100 km/h (0 to 100 mph) and memory is 1 to 100 km/h (0 to 100 mph).



## Odometer (Wheel Size Setting Mode)

Type distance traveled is indicated by "000" and displayed on the bottom line. Press and hold the function button 20" for 2 seconds, the computer and odometer will be reset and you'll wheel size setting.



## Clock

A "1" hour digital clock is indicated by the function button on the bottom line. To adjust time, press and hold the function button 20" for 2 seconds. The hour display will appear. Press the function button 20" one time to set in the current digit. The next minute display will appear. Repeat the process until you get a correct time.



## Tripmeter (Trip Information Reset Mode)

Tripmeter measurement is indicated by "000" and is displayed on the bottom line. Tripmeter is activated automatically with speedometer input. Holding 20" for 2 seconds, the tripmeter will be reset. Press the function button 20" for 2 seconds, the tripmeter will be reset. Press the function button 20" for 2 seconds, the tripmeter will be reset. ## Maximum Speed

Maximum speed measurement is indicated by "000" and is displayed on the bottom line. Maximum speed is stored in memory and updates only when a higher speed is reached. Press the maximum speed by holding the function button 20" for 4 seconds at 000 mode.



## Average Speed

Average speed measurement is indicated by "000" and is displayed on the bottom line. Average speed is calculated with the Trip Time 10" or 20" to the average speed only when riding.



## Trip Timer

Trip time measurement is indicated by "000" and is displayed on the bottom line. Trip time is activated automatically with speedometer input. Holding 20" for 2 seconds, the trip timer will be reset. Press the function button 20" for 2 seconds, the trip timer will be reset. Press the function button 20" for 2 seconds, the trip timer will be reset.



## Scan

In SCAN mode, all information can be read without pressing the key. If you want to go in different mode, press the function button 20" to enter.
