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Once Again to Zelda Marlene Wagman-Geller, 2008-11-04 A fascinating look at the stories behind the dedications of 50 literary classics Mary Shelley dedicated Frankenstein to her father her greatest champion Charlotte Bronte dedicated Jane Eyre to William Makepeace Thackeray for his enthusiastic review of the book's first edition Dostoyevsky dedicated The Brothers Karamazov to his typist turned lover Anna Grigoyevna And as this collection's title indicates F Scott Fitzgerald dedicated his masterpiece The Great Gatsby to his wife Zelda Often overlooked a novel's dedication can say much about an author and his or her relationship to the person for whom the book was consecrated Once Again to Zelda explores the dedications in fifty iconic books that are an intrinsic part of both literary and pop culture shedding light on the author's psyche as well as the social and historic context in which the book was first published Zelda Sayre Fitzgerald Linda Wagner-Martin, 2004-07-30 Linda Wagner Martin's Zelda Sayre Fitzgerald is a twenty first century story Using cultural and gender studies as contexts Wagner Martin brings new information to the story of the Alabama judge's daughter who at seventeen met her husband to be Scott Fitzgerald Swept away from her stable home life into Jazz Age New York and Paris Zelda eventually learned to be a writer and a painter and she came close to being a ballerina An evocative portrayal of a talented woman's professional and emotional conflicts this study contains extensive notes and new photographs

Heroines, new edition Kate Zambreno, 2024-03-05 A manifesto reclaiming the wives and mistresses of literary modernism that inspired a generation of writers and scholars reissued after more than a decade I am beginning to realize that taking the self out of our essays is a form of repression Taking the self out feels like obeying a gag order pretending an objectivity where there is nothing objective about the experience of confronting and engaging with and swooning over literature On the last day of December 2009 Kate Zambreno then an unpublished writer began a blog called Frances Farmer Is My Sister arising from her obsession with literary modernism and her recent transplantation to Akron Ohio where her partner held a university job Widely reposted Zambreno's blog became an outlet for her highly informed and passionate rants and melancholy portraits of the fates of the modernist wives and mistresses reclaiming the traditionally pathologized biographies of Vivienne Eliot Jane Bowles Jean Rhys and Zelda Fitzgerald writers and artists themselves who served as male writers' muses only to end their lives silenced erased and institutionalized Over the course of two years Frances Farmer Is My Sister helped create a community of writers and devised a new feminist discourse of writing in the margins and developing an alternative canon In Heroines Zambreno extends the polemic begun on her blog into a dazzling original work of literary scholarship Combining theories that have dictated what literature should be and who is allowed to write it she traces the genesis of a cultural template that consistently exiles feminine experience to the realm of the minor and diagnoses women for transgressing social bounds ANXIETY When she experiences it it's pathological writes Zambreno When he does it's existential With Heroines Zambreno provided a model for a newly subjectivized criticism prefiguring many group biographies

and forms of autotheory and hybrid memoirs that were to come in the years to follow A book that has become its own canon Heroines was named one of the 50 Books that define the past 5 Years in Literature by Flavorwire an Essential Feminist Manifesto by Dazed and one of the 50 Greatest Books by Women in Buzzfeed Fitzgerald's Craft of Short Fiction Alice Hall Petry,1989 Normal0falsefalsefalseMicrosoftInternetExplorer4 Fitzgerald s Craft of Short Fiction offers the first comprehensive study of the four collections of short stories that F Scott Fitzgerald 1896 1940 prepared for publication during his lifetime Flappers and Philosophers 1920 Tales of the Jazz Age 1922 All the Sad Young Men 1926 and Taps at Reveille 1935 These authorized collections which include works from the entire range of Fitzgerald s career from his undergraduate days at Princeton to his final contributions to Esquire magazine provide an ideal overview of his development as a short story writer Originally published in 1989 this volume draws upon Fitzgerald s copious personal correspondence biographical studies and all available criticism and analyzes how Fitzgerald perceived his achievements as a writer of short fiction from both artistic and commercial standpoints Petry pays close attention to the individual stories exploring how Fitzgerald s growing technical expertise and the evolution of his themes reflect changes in his personal life **Beyond the Mask** Kathleen A. The Gatsby Affair Kendall Taylor, 2018-08-08 The romance between F Scott Fitzgerald and Zelda Sayre has been celebrated as one of the greatest of the 20th century From the beginning their relationship was a tumultuous one in which the couple's excesses were as widely known as their passion for each other Despite their love both Scott and Zelda engaged in flirtations that threatened to tear the couple apart But none had a more profound impact on the two and on Scott's writing as the liaison between Zelda and a French aviator Edouard Joze Though other biographies have written of Joze as one of Scott's romantic rivals accounts of the pilot's effect on the couple have been superficial at best In *The Gatsby Affair* Scott Zelda and the Betrayal That Shaped an American Classic Kendall Taylor examines the dalliance between the southern belle and the French pilot from a fresh perspective Drawing on conversations and correspondence with Joze's daughter as well as materials from the Joze family archives Taylor sheds new light on this romantic triangle More than just a casual fling Zelda's tryst with Edouard affected Scott as much as it did his wife and ultimately influenced the author's most famous creation Jay Gatsby Were it not for Zelda's affair with the pilot Scott's novel might be less about betrayal and more about lost illusions Exploring the private motives of these public figures Taylor offers new explanations for their behavior In addition to the love triangle that included Joze Taylor also delves into an earlier event in Zelda's life a sexual assault she suffered as a teenager one that affected her future relationships Both a literary study and a probing look at an iconic couple's psychological makeup *The Gatsby Affair* offers readers a bold interpretation of how one of America's greatest novels was influenced *The Critical Reputation of F. often hilarious sometimes tenderhearted always evocative about defining moments of high school loserdom Brad Land Julianna Baggott Owen King Johanna Edwards and many more fresh talented writers explore their own angst humiliation heartache and other staples of teen life These essays perfectly capture what it was like to be in high school to experience so many things for the first time to assert independence while desperately trying to fit in to feel misunderstood and unable to articulate the wild swings between heartbreak anger and euphoria One writer recalls how his grandmother helped him with his home perm in preparation for the Senior Class picture another recounts her discovery sometime after hitting puberty of the power she held over boys and men while at the same time she felt herself at their mercy a third remembers the casual cruelties visited on him by the cooler kids and the cruelties he in turn inflicted on kids below him on the social ladder Utterly candid and compulsively readable these essays conjure up and untangle those raw and formative years The writers cringe and laugh at the teenagers they were but at the same time they honor their adolescence and the way it shaped their lives Because in truth beneath the layers of adult respectability we all still carry a little bit of our teenage selves around with us
