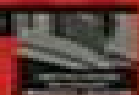

William A. Schabas, 2018-10-17 In the immediate aftermath of the armistice that ended the First World War the Allied nations of Britain France and Italy agreed to put the fallen German Emperor Kaiser Wilhelm II on trial in what would be the first ever international criminal tribunal In Britain Lloyd George campaigned for re election on the slogan hang the Kaiser but the Italians had only lukewarm support for a trial and there was outright resistance from the United States During the Peace Conference international lawyers gathered for the first time to debate international criminal justice They recommended trial of the Kaiser by an international tribunal for war crimes and the Americans relented agreeing to a trial for a supreme offence against international morality However the Kaiser had fled to the Netherlands where he obtained asylum and though the Allies threatened a range of measures if the former Emperor was not surrendered the Dutch refused and the demands were dropped in March 1920 This book from renowned legal scholar William A Schabas sheds light on perhaps the most important international trial that never was Schabas draws on numerous primary sources hitherto unexamined in published work including transcripts which vividly illuminate this period of international law making As such he has written a book which constitutes a history of the very beginnings of international criminal justice a history which has never before been fully told

Nazi Collaborators on Trial during the Cold War Richards Plavnieks, 2017-09-11 This book is a study of the legal reckoning with the crimes of the Latvian Auxiliary Security Police and its political dimensions in the Soviet Union West and East Germany and the United States in the context of the Cold War Decades of work by prosecutors have established the facts of Latvian collaboration with the Nazis during the Holocaust No group made a deeper mark in the annals of atrocity than the men of the so called Arajs Kommando and their leader Viktors Arj's who killed tens of thousands of Jews on Latvian

soil and participated in every aspect of the Holocaust by Bullets This study also has significance for coming to terms with Latvia's encounter with Nazism a process that was stunted and distorted by Latvia's domination by the USSR until 1991 Examining the country's most notorious killers their fates on both sides of the Iron Curtain and contemporary Latvians' responses in different political contexts this volume is a record of the earliest phases of this process which must now continue and to which this book contributes

Seeking Accountability for Nazi and War Crimes in East and Central Europe Irina Tcherneva, Vanessa Voisin, Eric Le Bourhis, 2022 The thirst for post World War II justice transcended the Cold War and mobilized diverse social groups This is a story of their multilayered and at times conflictual interactions In this edited collection sixteen historians develop a new approach to the trials against persons accused of war crimes and mass murder in Europe during the ascendancy of Nazism and the Second World War 1933-1945 Focusing on the social aspects of the demand for justice and making use of previously underexploited local and international sources contributors put to the test the notion of show trials and explore a range of judicial and political cultures from Germany to the Soviet Union Essays uncover the expectations around accountability and forms of mobilization on the part of a range of citizens involved in the trials survivors witnesses perpetrators Nazi hunters and civic activists In addition to the perspective of these citizens contributors invoke the expertise of reporters filmmakers historians investigators and prosecutors who shaped public representations of justice These shaping efforts the authors show often supported the desire of political authorities to benefit from the publicity of the trials and to contain the spontaneous dissemination of information The book's close examination of interactions between citizens and authorities thus demonstrates the extent and limits of what might be called a coproduction of justice in the process shedding light on the interdependence between historical knowledge and legal prosecution of mass crimes

Genocide, Ethnonationalism, and the United Nations Hannibal Travis, 2013 Genocide Ethnonationalism and the United Nations examines a series of related crises in human civilization growing out of conflicts between powerful states or empires and indigenous or stateless peoples This is the first book to attempt to explore the causes of genocide and other mass killing by a detailed exploration of UN archives covering the period spanning from 1945 through 2011 Hannibal Travis argues that large states and empires disproportionately committed or facilitated genocide and other mass killings between 1945 and 2011 His research incorporates data concerning factors linked to the scale of mass killing and recent findings in human rights political science and legal theory Turning to potential solutions he argues that the concept of genocide imagines a future system of global governance under which the nation state itself is made subject to law The United Nations however has deflected the possibility of such a cosmopolitical law It selectively condemns genocide and has established an institutional structure that denies most peoples subjected to genocide of a realistic possibility of global justice lacks a robust international criminal tribunal or UN army and even encourages security cooperation among states that have proven to be destructive of peoples in the past Questions raised include What have been the causes of mass killing during the period since

the United Nations Charter entered into force in 1945 How does mass killing spread across international borders and what is the role of resource wealth the arms trade and external interference in this process Have the United Nations or the International Criminal Court faced up to the problem of genocide and other forms of mass killing as is their mandate

Stalin's Soviet Justice David M. Crowe, 2019-06-13 From the show trials of the 1920s and 1930s to the London Conference this book examines the Soviet role in the Nuremberg IMT trial through the prism of the ideas and practices of earlier Soviet legal history detailing the evolution of Stalin's ideas about the trial of Nazi war criminals Stalin believed that an international trial for Nazi war criminals was the best way to show the world the sacrifices his country had made to defeat Hitler and he together with his legal mouthpiece Andrei Vyshinsky maintained tight control over Soviet representatives during talks leading up to the creation of the Nuremberg IMT trial in 1945 and the trial itself But Soviet prosecutors at Nuremberg were unable to deal comfortably with the complexities of an open western style legal proceeding which undercut their effectiveness throughout the trial However they were able to present a significant body of evidence that underscored the brutal nature of Hitler's racial war in Russia from 1941-45 a theme which became central to Stalin's efforts to redefine international criminal law after the war Stalin's *Soviet Justice* provides a nuanced analysis of the Soviet justice system at a crucial turning point in European history and it will be vital reading for scholars and advanced students of the legal history of the Soviet Union the history of war crimes and the aftermath of the Second World War *Justice Framed* Marcos

Zunino, 2019-03-14 Why are certain responses to past human rights violations considered instances of transitional justice while others are disregarded This study interrogates the history of the discourse and practice of the field to answer that question Zunino argues that a number of characteristics inherited as transitional justice emerged as a discourse in the 1980s and 1990s have shaped which practices of the present and the past are now regarded as valid responses to past human rights violations He traces these influential characteristics from Argentina's transition to democracy in 1983 the end of communism in Eastern Europe the development of international criminal justice and the South African truth commission of 1995 Through an analysis of the post World War II period the decolonisation process and the Cold War Zunino identifies a series of episodes and mechanisms omitted from the history of transitional justice because they did not conform to its accepted characteristics

After Nuremberg Robert Hutchinson, 2022-01-01 How the American High Commissioner for Germany set in motion a process that resulted in every non death row inmate walking free after the Nuremberg trials After Nuremberg is about the fleeting nature of American punishment for German war criminals convicted at the twelve Nuremberg trials of 1946-1949 Because of repeated American grants of clemency and parole ninety seven of the 142 Germans convicted at the Nuremberg trials many of them major offenders regained their freedom years sometimes decades ahead of schedule High ranking Nazi plunderers kidnappers slave laborers and mass murderers all walked free by 1958 High Commissioner for Occupied Germany John J McCloy and his successors articulated a vision of impartial American justice as inspiring and legitimizing their actions

as they concluded that German war criminals were entitled to all the remedies American laws offered to better their conditions and reduce their sentences Based on extensive archival research including newly declassified material this book explains how American policy makers best intentions resulted in a series of decisions from 1949 1958 that produced a self perpetuating bureaucracy of clemency and parole that rehabilitated unrepentant German abettors and perpetrators of theft slavery and murder while lending salience to the most reactionary elements in West German political discourse
