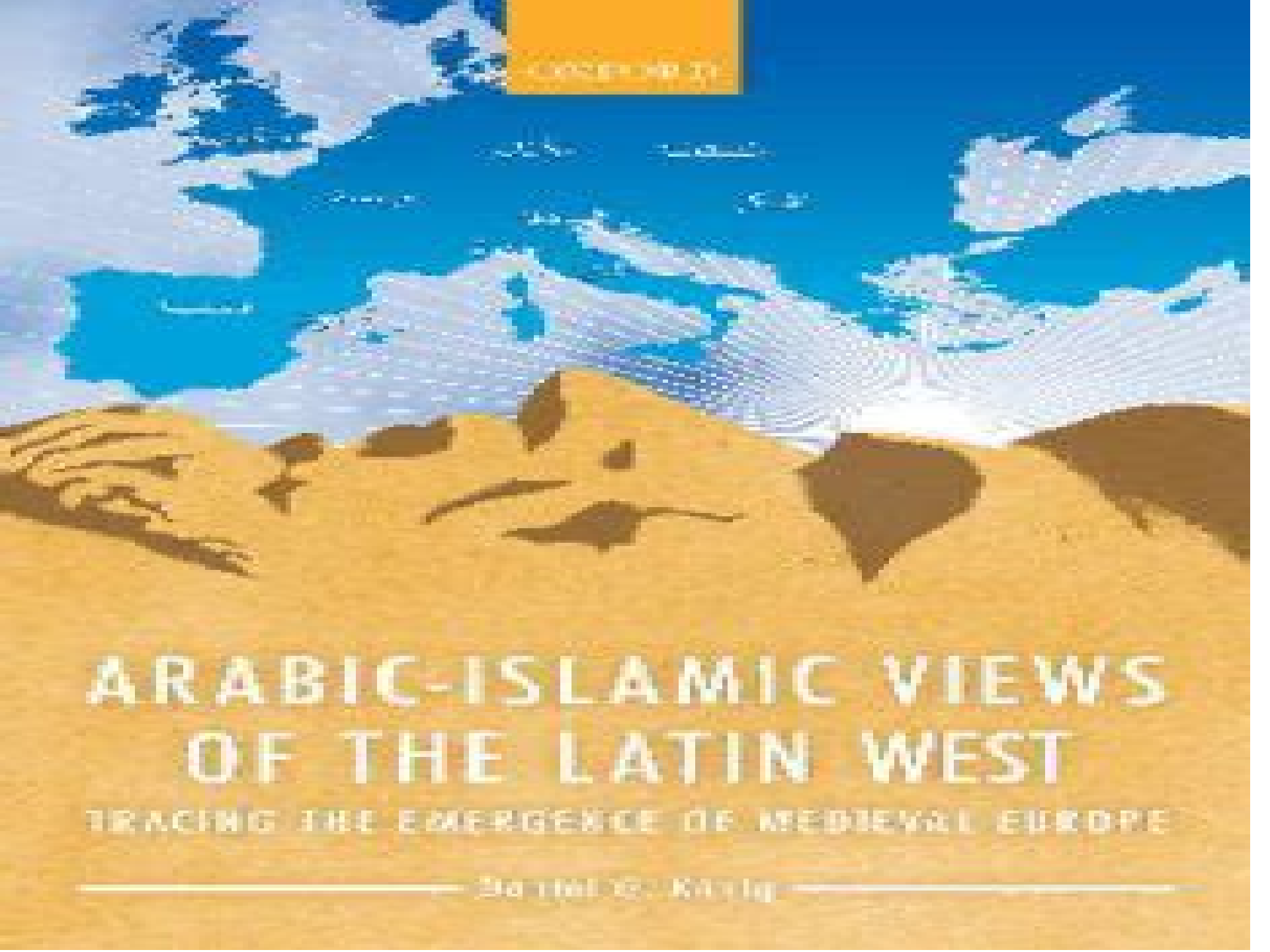

König, 2015-11-05 *Arabic Islamic Views of the Latin West* provides an insight into how the Arabic Islamic world perceived medieval Western Europe in an age that is usually associated with the rise and expansion of Islam the Spanish Reconquista and the Crusades Previous scholarship has maintained that the Arabic Islamic world regarded Western Europe as a cultural backwater at the periphery of civilization that clung to a superseded religion It holds mental barriers imposed by Islam responsible for the Muslim world's arrogant and ignorant attitude towards its northern neighbours This study refutes this view by focussing on the mechanisms of transmission and reception that characterized the flow of information between both cultural spheres By explaining how Arabic Islamic scholars acquired and processed data on medieval Western Europe it traces the two fold emergence of Latin Christian Europe a sphere that increasingly encroached upon the Mediterranean and therefore became more and more important in Arabic Islamic scholarly literature Chapter One questions previous interpretations of related Arabic Islamic records that reduce a large and differentiated range of Arabic Islamic perceptions to a single basic pattern subsumed under the keywords ignorance indifference and arrogance Chapter Two lists channels of transmission by means of which information on the Latin Christian sphere reached the Arabic Islamic sphere Chapter Three deals with the general factors that influenced the reception and presentation of this data at the hands of Arabic Islamic scholars Chapters Four to Eight analyse how these scholars acquired and dealt with information on themes such as the western dimension of the Roman Empire the Visigoths the Franks the papacy and finally Western Europe in the age of Latin Christian expansionism Against this background Chapter Nine provides a concluding re evaluation

Questions over the text's construction purpose and reception however have largely been ignored in current scholarship. This is despite both the text's important historical material and its crucial early date of creation. It has become commonplace for researchers to turn to the Futuh for information on a specific location or topic but to ignore the grander and in many ways more straightforward questions over the text's creation and limitations. This book looks to correct these gaps in knowledge by investigating the context, form, construction, content, and early reception history of al-Baladhuri's text.

Dynasties Intertwined traces the turbulent relationship between the Zirids of Ifriqiya and the Normans of Sicily during the eleventh and twelfth centuries. In doing so, it reveals the complex web of economic, political, cultural, and military connections that linked the two dynasties to each other and to other polities across the medieval Mediterranean. Furthermore, despite the contemporary interfaith holy wars happening around the Zirids and Normans, their relationship was never governed by an overarching ideology like jihad or crusade. Instead, both dynasties pursued policies that they thought would expand their power and wealth, either through collaboration or conflict. The relationship between the Zirids and Normans ultimately came to a violent end in the 1140s when a devastating drought crippled Ifriqiya. The Normans seized this opportunity to conquer lands across the Ifriqiyian coast, bringing an end to the Zirid dynasty and forming the Norman kingdom of Africa, which persisted until the Almohad conquest of Mahdia in 1160. Previous scholarship on medieval North Africa during the reign of the Zirids has depicted the region as one of instability and political anarchy that rendered local lords powerless in the face of foreign conquest. Matt King shows that to the contrary, the Zirids and other local lords in Ifriqiya were integral parts of the far-reaching political and economic networks across the Mediterranean. Despite the eventual collapse of the Zirid dynasty at the hands of the Normans, *Dynasties Intertwined* makes clear that its emirs were active and consequential Mediterranean players for much of the eleventh and twelfth centuries, with political agency independent of their Christian neighbors across the Strait of Sicily.
