In this book Helmut Jahn is revealed as an architect committed to exploring the material and perceptual possibilities of creating architecture in a new millennium one with a simplicity of form and construction and a clear expression of its component parts *The Letters of Philip Webb, Volume II* John Aplin, 2015-12-22 Philip Webb was a British architect known as a founder of the Arts and Crafts movement and also a key member of the Pre Raphaelite circle He had a long association with William Morris and was responsible for the design of the hugely influential Red House Morris's first home Webb's letters will be of interest to art and architecture historians **The Autopoiesis of Architecture, Volume II** Patrik Schumacher, 2012-04-24 This is the second part of a major theoretical work by Patrik Schumacher which outlines how the discipline of architecture should be understood as its own distinct system of communication Autopoiesis comes from the Greek and means literally self production it was first adopted in biology in the 1970s to describe the essential characteristics of life as a circular self organizing system and has since been transposed into a theory of social systems This new approach offers architecture an arsenal of general comparative concepts It allows architecture to be understood as a distinct discipline which can be analyzed in elaborate detail while at the same time offering insightful comparisons with other subject areas such as art science and political discourse On the basis of such comparisons the book insists on the necessity of disciplinary autonomy and argues for a sharp demarcation of design from both art and engineering Schumacher accordingly argues controversially that design as a discipline has its own sui generis intelligence with its own internal logic reach and limitations Whereas the first volume provides the theoretical groundwork for Schumacher's ideas focusing on architecture as an autopoietic system with its own theory history medium and its unique societal function the second volume addresses the specific contemporary challenges and tasks that architecture faces It formulates these tasks looking specifically at how architecture is seeking to organize and articulate the complexity of post fordist network society The volume explicitly addresses how current architecture can upgrade its design methodology in the face of an increasingly demanding task environment characterized by both complexity and novelty Architecture's specific role within contemporary society is explained and its relationship to politics is clarified Finally the new global style of Parametricism is introduced and theoretically grounded *As I Was Saying, Volume 2* Colin Rowe, 1999-08-18 Colin Rowe has achieved legendary status as one of a handful of outstanding studio teachers of architecture and urban design to emerge within the last two generations His writings reveal the powerful insight and dispassionate authoritative intelligence that mark him as one of the preeminent architectural thinkers of this perplexing half century Divided into three volumes in more or less chronological order *As I Was Saying* includes articles essays eulogies lectures reviews and memoranda Some appeared only in obscure journals and many are published here for the first time *The Site* Rob Wilson, George Kafka, Sophie Lovell, Fiona Shipwright, Florian
