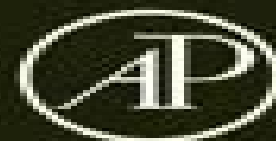

Key Determinants of Biodiversity, Ecosystem Functioning and Restoration in Climate Change Sensitive Ecosystems Hui Zhang,Xiang Liu,Robert John,2023-11-27 Human activities such as agriculture and mining have led to serious negative effects on biodiversity and important ecosystem services including biodiversity loss and climate change Thus it is important to quantify the key determinants of biodiversity ecosystem functioning and ecological restoration of degraded plant communities in climate change sensitive ecosystems i e subalpine and alpine meadow communities in Qinghai tropical rainforests and tropical mountains In this way effective management policy and methods can be developed to reduce the influence of climate change on these climate change sensitive ecosystems The aforementioned human activities continue to destroy and degrade plant communities and ecosystem functioning Climatic changes further exacerbate negative impacts and may trigger rapid loss of species precipitate decline and changes in the flows of ecosystem goods and services As the collective anthropogenic influence intensifies some ecosystems may be more sensitive than others to these changes Ecosystems that contribute greatly to human well being through the delivery of biodiversity and ecosystem benefits should be the focus of particular concern There are key knowledge gaps on the specific nature of anthropogenic impacts species and ecosystem responses and possible management and mitigation measures Comprehensive documentation of these aspects from highly sensitive regions and ecosystems is urgently needed particularly at fine scales which is relevant for developing management and mitigation measures Pathways such as ecological restoration can offset some of the impacts but even quantifying the impacts of observed and anticipated changes is far from adequate and other mitigation measures must be considered

Searcy,Stephen Nowicki,2010-01-01 Gull chicks beg for food from their parents Peacocks spread their tails to attract potential mates Meerkats alert family members of the approach of predators But are these and other animals sometimes dishonest That s what William Searcy and Stephen Nowicki ask in The Evolution of Animal Communication They take on the fascinating yet perplexing question of the

dependability of animal signaling systems The book probes such phenomena as the begging of nesting birds alarm calls in squirrels and primates carotenoid coloration in fish and birds the calls of frogs and toads and weapon displays in crustaceans Do these signals convey accurate information about the signaler its future behavior or its environment Or do they mislead receivers in a way that benefits the signaler For example is the begging chick really hungry as its cries indicate or is it lobbying to get more food than its brothers and sisters Searcy and Nowicki take on these and other questions by developing clear definitions of key issues by reviewing the most relevant empirical data and game theory models available and by asking how well theory matches data They find that animal communication is largely reliable but that this basic reliability also allows the clever deceiver to flourish Well researched and clearly written their book provides new insight into animal communication behavior and evolution

The Private Lives of Birds Bridget Stutchbury, 2011-04-10 Biologist Bridget Stutchbury takes readers along on her escapades as a bird detective stalking subjects through the woods for hours taking blood samples from nestlings for DNA analysis and mounting miniature tracking devices on tiny backs She captures several young white and brown male purple martins and paints them the darker color of mature males to see if the painted youngsters are more successful than their unaltered peers in wresting away nest sites from older males They are The Private Lives of Birds is a treasure trove of fascinating insights into bird behavior But understanding the social lives of birds does much more than slake our curiosity Aware that many birds will not occupy an area unless other birds are already there biologists used mirrors and two dimensional cutouts to lure Atlantic puffins to establish colonies off the coast of Maine getting curious puffins to visit the site and linger long enough to encounter a live bird As Stutchbury says Trying to save birds without understanding what makes them tick is a shot in the dark birds are highly social and their social needs are at least as important as their physical needs

female songbirds and was probably present in the ancestor of modern songbirds Odom et al 2014 Nature Communications These recent findings challenge the view that sexual dimorphism in the expression and complexity of song is largely the outcome of sexual selection on males It is now clear that understanding the evolution of bird song requires explaining variation within and among species in the expression and complexity of female song To do this we need a better understanding of the nature of variation in female song in different contexts and systems as well as the fitness costs and benefits of variation in the expression and complexity of female song This Research Topic draws together current research on female song with the goal of understanding the fitness costs and benefits of the diversity of female singing behaviour apparent among songbirds It includes articles ranging from single species studies investigating how female song varies with context and contrasts with male song to comparative analyses exploring relationships between female song and ecological social and other factors as well as opinion pieces
