#### Defining the root cause problems and educator expectations

The science of behavior provides insights into the factors that predict and explain why behaviors occur. It also identifies practices that can encourage healthy and positive behaviors while reducing problematic ones. As educators, applying this science allows us to go beyond merely observing the form of a behavior—what it looks and sounds like—and instead focus on its function. By understanding the reasons behind a student's behavior and the purpose it serves for them, we can better address and support their needs.

### Why Understanding Behavior is Important

- 1) Gives us the ability to create and implement effective strategies to prevent the behavior
- 2) Provides us with insight to teach skillful replacement behaviors
- 3) We can be more responsive to students after behavior occurs

The science of human behavior operates of one core assumption, all behavior is directly related to the environment in which it occurs

What makes a behavior a problem and what are appropriate expectations? A problem is the discrepancy between what is expected for a person to do and what the person is actually doing. The existing discrepancy is the problem because it means there is a gap that can lead to a negative outcome for that person or others. The person isn't the problem, but rather the discrepancy between what is expected and what is happening. We have to work to define the actually problem creating the behavior before we can intentional solve for it. Understand that behavior expectations come from adults. Sometimes educator expectations may not be consistent with where the student is developmentally. Our own expectations for behavior are often heavily influenced by our own lived experiences.
