SYSTEMS IN THE BODY - PART TWO

LEARNING INTENTION:

Students will learn about the circulatory system and the respiratory system inside the human body.

SUCCESS CRITERIA:

- describe the components of blood in the human body
- calculate the amount of blood flowing in their body
- complete the diagram of the circulatory system throughout the body and the heart
- provide a written description of how the heart pumps blood in and out
- research an interesting fact about the heart and share with a classmate
- conduct heart rate tests during various activities
- identify main parts of the respiratory system and describe their functions
- create and test a model of a lung and disphragm in the human body
- make a prediction, record observations and conclusions about the function of the diaphragm as part of the respiratory system.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- a copy of "Your Blood" worksheet 1 for each student
- a copy of "The Circulatory System" worksheet
 2, 3, and 4 for each student
- a copy of "Get That Heart Pumping!" worksheet 5 for each student
- a copy of "The Respiratory System" worksheet 6 for each student
- a copy of "A Model of a Lung" worksheet 7 and 8 for each student
- · access to the internet or local library

- access to a gymnasium or outdoor space, skipping ropes, benches/ stairs, music, stopwatches or clock
- an empty 1L plastic pop bottle, 2 round balloons (each about 30cm in diameter), a straw, an elastic band, a small ball of plasticene, scissors (for each student or pair of students)
- pencils, pencil crayons, markers, chart paper, clipboards

PROCEDURE:

*This lesson can be done as one long lesson, or be done in five or six shorter lessons.

- Using worksheet 1, do a shared reading activity with the students. This will allow for reading practice. Along with the content, discussion of certain vocabulary words would be of benefit for students to fully understand the passage. If students are measuring their weight in pounds, simply have them divide their weight by 2.2 to get their equivalent weight in kilograms. (There are 2.2 pounds in 1 kilogram of weight).
- Give students worksheet 2. Using red, blue, and yellow colored pencils, they will color the flow of blood circulation inside the human body.
 As a large group, read about and discuss the purpose of the arteries, capillaries, and veins in the body.
- Give students worksheet 3. They will use red and blue colored pencils to indicate the location and direction that blood flows in and out of the heart.
- Give students worksheet 4 to complete. They
 will need access to the internet to research an
 interesting fact about the human heart. They
 will record it and share with a classmate.
- 5. Take students to the gymnasium or suitable outdoor space. Give them worksheet 5 to complete as they test their heart rate performing different activities. Ensure that students have access to benches/ stairs, skipping ropes, music, and other assorted student requested items.
