Black Power in the Bluff City Shirletta Kinchen, 2024-01-12 During the civil rights era Memphis gained a reputation for having one of the South's strongest NAACP branches But that organization led by the city's black elite was hardly the only driving force in the local struggle against racial injustice In the late sixties Black Power proponents advocating economic political and cultural self determination effectively mobilized Memphis's African American youth using an array of moderate and radical approaches to protest and change conditions on their campuses and in the

community While Black Power activism on the coasts and in the Midwest has attracted considerable scholarly attention much less has been written about the movement's impact outside these hotbeds In *Black Power in the Bluff City* Shirletta J Kinchen helps redress that imbalance by examining how young Memphis activists like Coby Smith and Charles Cabbage dissatisfied by the pace of progress in a city emerging from the Jim Crow era embraced Black Power ideology to confront such challenges as gross disparities in housing education and employment as well as police brutality and harassment Two closely related Black Power organizations the Black Organizing Project and the Invaders became central to the local black youth movement in the late 1960s Kinchen traces these groups participation in the 1968 sanitation workers strike including the controversy over whether their activities precipitated events that culminated in Martin Luther King's assassination and their subsequent involvement in War on Poverty programs The book also shows how Black Power ideology drove activism at the historically black LeMoyne Owen College scene of a 1968 administration building takeover and at the predominately white Memphis State University where African American students transformed the campus by creating parallel institutions that helped strengthen black student camaraderie and consciousness in the face of marginalization Drawing on interviews with activists FBI files newspaper accounts from the period and many other sources the author persuasively shows not only how an emerging generation helped define the black freedom struggle in Memphis but also how they applied the tenets of Black Power to shape the broader community Shirletta J Kinchen is an assistant professor in the Pan African Studies Department at the University of Louisville

Sidelined Simon Henderson, 2013-03-01 A sociologist and oral historian explores the interwoven histories of sports and civil rights activism in this extensively researched volume In 1968 noted sociologist Harry Edwards established the Olympic Project for Human Rights calling for a boycott of that year's games in Mexico City as a demonstration against racial discrimination Though the boycott never materialized Edwards's ideas struck a chord with athletes and incited African American Olympians Tommie Smith and John Carlos to protest by raising their black gloved fists on the podium after receiving their medals *Sidelined* draws upon a wide range of historical materials and more than forty oral histories with athletes and administrators to explore how the black athletic revolt used professional and college sports to promote the struggle for civil rights in the late 1960s By examining activists successes and failures in promoting racial equality on one of the most public stages in the world Henderson sheds new light on an often overlooked subject and gives voice to those who fought for civil rights both on the field and off

Waiting for Gautreaux Alexander Polikoff, 2007-05-11 Winner 2006 The American Lawyer Lifetime Achievement Award On his thirty ninth birthday in 1966 Alexander Polikoff a volunteer ACLU attorney and partner in a Chicago law firm met some friends to discuss a pro bono case Over lunch the four talked about the Chicago Housing Authority construction program All the new public housing it seemed was going into black neighborhoods If discrimination was prohibited in public schools wasn't it also prohibited in public housing And so began *Gautreaux v CHA* and HUD a case that from its rocky beginnings would roll on year after year decade after decade carrying

Polikoff and his colleagues to the nation's Supreme Court to face then solicitor general Robert Bork establishing precedents for suits against the discriminatory policies of local housing authorities often abetted by HUD and setting the stage for a nationwide experiment aimed at ending the concentration and racialization of poverty through public housing. Sometimes Kafkaesque, sometimes simply inspiring and never less than absorbing, the story of Gautreaux told by its principal lawyer moves with ease through local and national civil rights history, legal details, political matters, and the personal costs and rewards of a commitment to fairness, equality, and justice. Both the memoir of a dedicated lawyer and the narrative of a tenacious pursuit of equality, this story itself a critical, still unfolding chapter in recent American history, urges us to take an essential step in ending the racial inequality that Alexis de Toqueville prophetically named America's most formidable evil.

Jim Crow Terminals Anke Ortlepp, 2017-07-01. Historical accounts of racial discrimination in transportation have focused until now on trains, buses, and streetcars and their respective depots, terminals, stops, and other public accommodations. It is essential to add airplanes and airports to this narrative, says Anke Ortlepp. Air travel stands at the center of the twentieth century's transportation revolution, and airports embodied the rapidly mobilizing, increasingly prosperous, and cosmopolitan character of the postwar United States. When segregationists inscribed local definitions of whiteness and blackness onto sites of interstate and even international transit, they not only brought the incongruities of racial separation into sharp relief but also obligated the federal government to intervene. Ortlepp looks at African American passengers, civil rights organizations, the federal government, and judiciary, and airport planners, architects, and managers as actors in shaping aviation's legal, cultural, and built environments. She relates the struggles of black travelers to enjoy the same freedoms on the airport grounds that they enjoyed in the aircraft cabin in the context of larger shifts in the postwar social, economic, and political order. Jim Crow terminals, Ortlepp shows us, were both spatial expressions of sweeping change and sites of confrontation over the renegotiation of racial identities. Hence, this new study situates itself in the scholarly debate over the multifaceted entanglements of race and space.
