- 1. Punctuation like periods and commas go inside the quotation marks. Quotes within a quote are shown with single quote marks. Use commas to separate words in a series, but not before the "and." "No truer words about education were spoken than by Nelson Mandela when he said "Education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change the world," explained the principal to the students, teachers and parents.
- Numbers one through nine should be spelled out. Use figures for 10 and above.
  - > If a number begins a sentence, spell it out.
    - Forty students joined the program. The room could barely hold 40 students.
  - > Always use figures for ages (She is 5 years old.), percentages (4 percent to 12 percent), time (6 p.m., 9:30 am.), street numbers (1 Boot Road) and days of the month (Jan. 1, 2013, NOT 1st)
  - > Money: Use the dollar sign (\$3, \$30, \$30,000). Use exact figures up to \$1 million. On figures more than \$1 million, use decimals (\$3.5 million, \$3.85 billion).
