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Architecture in Play Tamar Zinguer, 2015 Created for children but designed by adults with considerable ingenuity architectural toys have long offered a window on a much larger world In *Architecture in Play* Tamar Zinguer explores the nearly two hundred year period over which such playthings have reflected changing attitudes toward form structure and permanence echoing modernist experiments and stylistic inclinations in fascinating ways while also incorporating technological advances in their systems of construction Zinguer's history of these toys reveals broader social and economic trends from their respective periods Used in the intimacy of the domestic environment a setting that encouraged the eradication of formal habits and a reconceiving of visual orders architectural toys ultimately intimated notions of the modern Amply illustrated and engagingly written this book sheds valuable light on this fascinating relation between household toys and the deeper trends and ideas from which they sprang Focusing on four primary building materials wood stone metal and paper Tamar Zinguer discusses a series of important architectural toys Friedrich Froebel's Gifts 1836 cubes spheres and cylinders that are gradually broken down to smaller geometrical parts Anchor Stone Building Blocks 1877 comprising hundreds of miniature stone shapes that yield castles forts and churches Meccano 1901 and Erector Set 1911 including small metal girders to construct bridges and skyscrapers mimetic of contemporary steel structures and The Toy 1950 and House of Cards 1952 designed by Charles and Ray Eames which are lightweight cardboard kits of parts based on methods of prefabrication Book jacket *Architecture in Play* Tamar Zinguer, 2006

Modern Architecture and an International Sensibility Naina Gupta, 2025-05-30 *Modern Architecture and an International Sensibility* A Curious Cross Atlantic Constellation presents an alternative history of internationalism and modernism with a focus on the role of architecture and spatial practices Beginning at the tail end of the peace movements the turn of the twentieth century and ending with the Nuremberg trials the book highlights the part played by individual agency social reform and architecture in moulding a working everyday definition of what it meant to be international during this time By viewing internationalism through the lens of the individual and the body both as initiator and subject it is repositioned as an integral part of everyday life rather than simply understood to be concerned with geopolitical relations between nations and their institutions The book furthers a research methodology that is multidisciplinary and transnational It will therefore be of interest to researchers and students of architecture and international history

Architecture and Dystopia Dario Donetti, 2020-02-08 A homage to the 1973 publication of *Architecture and Utopia* by Manfredo Tafuri echoed in the title this book is devoted to the radical experiences of the 1960s and to their consequences for the most recent developments in contemporary architecture As a response to the profound crisis of Western culture that emerged in the 1960s radical artists from Italy Austria England and Japan called into question the foundations of modernist utopias They transmuted the difficulties of capitalism into a repertory of startling images that revealed the disturbing realities of consumer society even in those places still resistant to the penetration of

Deconstructing LEGO Jonathan Rey Lee, 2020-09-08 This book investigates a paradox of creative yet scripted play how LEGO invites players to build freely with and within its highly structured ideologically laden toy system First this book considers theories and methods for deconstructing LEGO as a medium of bricolage the creative reassembly of already significant elements Then it pieces together readings of numerous LEGO sets advertisements videogames films and other media that show how LEGO constructs five ideologies of play construction play dramatic play digital play transmedia play and attachment play From suburban traffic patterns to architectural croissants from feminized mini doll bodies to toys to life stories from virtual construction to playful fan creations this book explores how the LEGO medium conveys ideological messages not by transmitting clear statements but by providing implicit instructions for how to reassemble meanings it had all along

Murphy, 2025-02-18 A comprehensive history of the women architects who left their enduring mark on American Modernism In the decades preceding World War II professional architecture schools enrolled increasing numbers of women but career success did not come easily *Women Architects at Work* tells the stories of the resilient and resourceful women who surmounted barriers of sexism racism and classism to take on crucial roles in the establishment and growth of Modernism across the United States Mary Anne Hunting and Kevin D Murphy describe how the Cambridge School of Architecture and Landscape Architecture in Massachusetts evolved for the professional education of

women between 1916 and 1942 While alumnae such as Eleanor Agnes Raymond Victorine du Pont Homsey and Sarah Pillsbury Harkness achieved some notoriety others like Elizabeth Ann Campbell Knapp and Louisa Vaughan Conrad have been largely absent from histories of Modernism Hunting and Murphy describe how these innovative practitioners capitalized on social educational and professional ties to achieve success and used architecture to address social concerns including how modernist ideas could engage with community and the environment Some joined women led architectural firms while others partnered with men or contributed to Modernism as retailers of household furnishings writers and educators photographers and designers or fine artists With stunning illustrations *Women Architects at Work* offers new histories of recognized figures while recovering the stories of previously unsung women all of whom contributed to the modernization of American architecture and design
