Morris, 2007 Huckleberry Finn dressing as a girl is a famously comic scene in Mark Twain s novel but hardly out of character for the author that is Twain troubled gender in much of his otherwise traditional fiction depicting children whose sexual identities are switched at birth tomboys same sex married couples and even a male French painter who impersonates his own fictive sister and becomes engaged to another man This book explores Mark Twain s extensive use of cross dressing across his career by exposing the substantial cast of characters who masqueraded as members of the opposite sex or who otherwise defied gender expectations Linda Morris grounds her study in an understanding of the era s theatrical cross dressing and changing mores and even events in the Clemens household She examines and interprets Twain s exploration of characters who transgress gendered conventions while tracing the degree to which themes of gender disruption interact with other themes such as his critique of race his concern with death in his classic boys books and his career long preoccupation with twins and twinning Approaching familiar texts in
