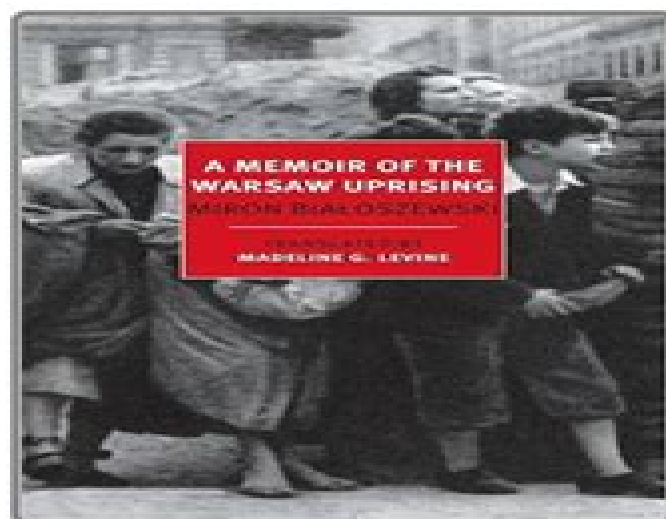

A Memoir of the Warsaw Uprising Miron Bialoszewski, 2015-10-27 On August 1 1944 Miron Bialoszewski later to gain renown as one of Poland's most innovative poets went out to run an errand for his mother and ran into history With Soviet forces on the outskirts of Warsaw the Polish capital revolted against five years of Nazi occupation an uprising that began in a spirit of heroic optimism Sixty three days later it came to a tragic end The Nazis suppressed the insurgents ruthlessly reducing Warsaw to rubble while slaughtering some 200 000 people mostly through mass executions The Red Army simply looked on Bialoszewski's blow by blow account of the uprising brings it alive in all its desperate urgency Here we are in the shoes of a young man slipping back and forth under German fire dodging sniper bullets collapsing with exhaustion rescuing the wounded burying the dead An indispensable and unforgettable act of witness *A Memoir of the Warsaw Uprising* is also a major work of literature Bialoszewski writes in short stabbing splintered breathless sentences attuned to the glaring identity of now His pages are full of a white knuckled poetry that resists the very destruction it records Madeline G Levine has extensively revised her 1977 translation and passages that were unpublishable in Communist Poland have been restored

The Penguin Book of Polish Short Stories Antonia Lloyd-Jones, 2025-06-05 A revelatory and richly varied collection of Poland's greatest short stories with a foreword by Nobel Prize winner Olga Tokarczuk Witty surprising and sparkling this anthology is an essential exploration of Polish literature Its thirty nine superb stories run the length of the literal and imaginative creation of Poland from 1918 when Poland regained its independence after 123 years of colonization by the neighbouring empires to the present The stories include *Miss Winczewska* by the acclaimed twentieth century writer Maria Dabrowska 1889-1965 based on her experience of helping to establish a library for soldiers at the Citadel military base in Warsaw in the interwar period and *In the Shadow of Brooklyn* by Stanislaw Dygat 1914-1978 the comical tale of a young man's envy of what he imagines to be his father's success with women At the contemporary end it includes a story by Nobel Prize winner Olga Tokarczuk 1962 *The Green Children* a historical story set in 1656 narrated by a Scottish doctor who as the Polish king's physician travels about the wilds of Poland and encounters two feral children Curated by Antonia Lloyd Jones this anthology is a refreshing and glorious new collection of the best in Polish literature **Muhammad** Maxime

Rodinson, 2021-03-02 A classic secular history of the prophet Muhammad that vividly recreates the fascinating time in which Islam was born Maxime Rodinson both a maverick Marxist and a distinguished professor at the Sorbonne first published his biography of Muhammad in 1960 The book a classic in its field has been widely read ever since Rodinson though deeply versed in scholarly studies of the Prophet does not seek to add to it here but to introduce Muhammad first of all as a man of flesh and blood who led a life of extraordinary drama and shaped history as few others have Equally he seeks to lay out an understanding of Muhammad's legacy and Islam as what he called an ideological movement similar to the universalist religions of Christianity and Buddhism as well as the secular movement of Marxism but possessing a singular commitment to

the deeply ingrained idea that Islam offers not only a path to salvation but for many above all the ideal of a just society to be realized on earth Rodinson's book begins by introducing the specific land and the larger world into which Muhammad was born and the development of his prophetic calling It then follows the steps of his career and the way his leadership gave birth to a religion and a state A final chapter considers the world as Islam has transformed it **Dissipatio H.G. Morselli,2020-12-01 A fantastic and philosophical vision of the apocalypse by one of the most striking Italian novelists of the twentieth century From his solitary *buen retiro* in the mountains the last man on earth drives to the capital Chrysopolis to see if anyone else has survived the Vanishing But there's no one else living or dead in that city of holy plutocracy with its fifty six banks and as many churches He'd left the metropolis to escape his fellow humans and their struggles and ambitions but to find that the entire human race has evaporated in an instant is more than he had bargained for Meanwhile life itself the rest of nature is just beginning to flourish now that human beings are gone Guido Morselli's arresting postapocalyptic novel written just before he died by suicide in 1973 depicts a man much like the author himself lonely brilliant difficult and a world much like our own mesmerized by money speed and machines *Dissipatio H.G.* is a precocious portrait of our Anthropocene world and a philosophical last will and testament from a great Italian outsider Down Below Leonora

Carrington,2017-04-18 A stunning work of memoir and an unforgettable depiction of the brilliance and madness by one of Surrealism's most compelling figures In 1937 Leonora Carrington later to become one of the twentieth century's great painters of the weird the alarming and the wild was a nineteen year old art student in London beautiful and unapologetically rebellious At a dinner party she met the artist Max Ernst The two fell in love and soon departed to live and paint together in a farmhouse in Provence In 1940 the invading German army arrested Ernst and sent him to a concentration camp Carrington suffered a psychotic break She wept for hours Her stomach became the mirror of the earth of all worlds in a hostile universe and she tried to purify the evil by compulsively vomiting As the Germans neared the south of France a friend persuaded Carrington to flee to Spain Facing the approach of robots of thoughtless fleshless beings she packed a suitcase that bore on a brass plate the word Revelation This was only the beginning of a journey into madness that was to end with Carrington confined in a mental institution overwhelmed not only by her own terrible imaginings but by her doctor's sadistic course of treatment In *Down Below* she describes her ordeal in which the agonizing and the marvelous were equally combined with a startling almost impersonal precision and without a trace of self pity Like Daniel Paul Schreber's *Memoirs of My Nervous Illness* *Down Below* brings the hallucinatory logic of madness home *A Favourite of the Gods and A Compass Error* Sybille

Bedford,2017-07-11 *A Favourite of the Gods* is the story of two generations of a single family united by a strong matrilineal bond but divided by the customs of their differing nationalities Anna Howland the matriarch and American heiress born in the 1870s to a prominent liberal New England family marries an Italian prince and makes her home in Rome her daughter Constanza the favorite of the title inherits her mother's beauty intelligence and wealth along with her father's Catholicism

which she soon rejects When disaster strikes Anna and the prince fall back on the standards of behavior of their disparate cultures Constanza with her European upbringing is free to plot her own course and she does so with daring making an unconventional life for herself in England and on the continent during and after the First World War Her own daughter Flavia is the heroine of A Compass Error which begins where the first novel concludes Flavia too is a brilliant young woman though both more brash and more faltering than her mother studying for her entrance exam to Oxford when she becomes involved with a mysterious woman whose arrival at a sensitive moment in Flavia s adolescence will alter both her and her mother s lives forever

Primitive Man as Philosopher Paul Radin,2017-02-21 Anthropology is a science whose most significant discoveries have come when it has taken its bearings from literature and what makes Paul Radin s Primitive Man as Philosopher a seminal piece of anthropological inquiry is that it is also a book of enduring wonder Writing in the 1920s when anthropology was still young Radin set out to show that primitive cultures are as intellectually sophisticated and venturesome as any of their civilized counterparts The basic questions about the structure of the natural world the nature of right and wrong and the meaning of life and death as well as basic methods of considering the truth or falsehood of the answers those questions give rise to are Radin argues recognizably consistent across the whole range of human societies He rejects both the romantic myth of the noble savage and the rationalist dismissal of the primitive mind as essentially undeveloped averring that the anthropologist and the anthropologist s subject meet on the same philosophical ground and only when that is acknowledged can anthropology begin in earnest The argument is clearly and forcibly made in pages that also contain an extraordinary collection of poems proverbs myths and tales from a host of different cultures making Primitive Man as Philosopher not only a lasting contribution to the discipline of anthropology but a unique rich and fascinating anthology one that both illuminates and enlarges our imagination of the human
