- Asia: The destination Columbus was searching for He wanted to get spices & silk from Asia, after Europeans discovered new products during the Crusades.
- Aztec: A large native tribe that was living in present-day Central Mexico when Europeans began exploring the region. They had one of the world's largest cities (that was a center of trade), & would trade for goods bought from far away. Codés destroyed the Aztec civilization.
- Christopher Columbus: (1451 1505) An Italian explorer who sailed for Spain & traveled to the American continents in 1492 to look for a new trade route to Asia (India).
 - His four trips made Europe aware of the <u>New World</u> & resulted in further exploration & the establishment of colonies.
 - Because of his voyage, other nations in Europe worked to profit from the New World as Spain had
 - Spanish power in the New World took time to develop, as Columbus did not reach the mainland of the New World until his third voyage.
- Development of Spanish colonies in the New World: Organized through land grants given to property holders in Spain.
- European success in conquering the New World: Native Americans had no natural protection from diseases brought by Europeans.
- Ferdinand It: Paid for Columbus's first journey in hopes that he would find a new trade route to Asia.
- Francisco Pizarro: (ca. 1475 1541) A Spanish soldier whose army defeated those of the inca empire. He founded the city of Lima, which is the present-day capital of Peru.
- Hernán Cortés: (1485 1547) A Spanish explorer who defeated the Aztec empire & claimed large areas of Mexico for Spain.
- Inca: The largest empire of native people on the American continents before Columbus arrived. The Inca lived in South America. They were conquered by Pizarro.
- Isabella I: See Queen Isabella I of Spain, below
- Missionaries: See Spanish missionaries, below

Spain had a long & lasting impact.

- Modern-day results of Spanish colonization: Most people in the Americas still speak Spanish, & most Latin Americans practice Roman Catholicism. Southwest culture still has elements of Spanish influence, including names of American Southwest cities such as Santa Fe & Western cities such as San Francisco. This shows
- New Spain: One of four Spanish colonies in the New World. It was ruled by a vicercy (an official chosen by the king) from Mexico. Their main goal was to obtain wealth.
- New World: North America, South America, & the Caribbean. This term compares them to the Old World of Europe, Africa, & Asia.
 - One reason for the Europeans' success in conquering the New World was that Native Americans had no natural protection from diseases brought by Europeans.
 - The development of Spanish colonies in the New World was organized through land grants given to property holders in Spain.
- Portugal: Spain wished to compete with Portugal for trade.
- Queen Isabella I of Spain: paid for Columbus's voyage to find a new trade route to Asia, but was unsure if
