Feest, Ute Kuhlemann, 2007 *New World England's First View of America* *A New World* Kim Sloan, 2007 This beautiful book reproduces in full the famous and rarely seen British Museum collection of drawings and watercolours made by John White who in 1585 accompanied a group of English settlers sent by Sir Walter Raleigh to found a colony in Virginia along the tidewaters of coastal North Carolina Whites duties included making visual records of everything then unknown in England including plants animals and birds as well as the human inhabitants especially their dress weapons tools and ceremonies The collection also includes his watercolours of Florida and Brazilian Indians and the Inuit encountered by Martin Frobisher In this landmark catalogue each work is reproduced in colour and is thoroughly described supplemented by engravings by Theodor de Bry and other comparable works The introduction is followed by three specially commissioned chapters covering John White himself the indigenous inhabitants and their historical context The book explores White's role as a colonist surveyor and artist who not only recorded the plants and animals but also provided a window on a now lost Native American culture and way of life

A New World Kim Sloan, 2010-05 In 1585 John White joined a group of Englishmen to found a colony in Virginia along the tidewaters of coastal North Carolina This book reproduces the celebrated but rarely seen Brit Mus collection of watercolors made by this gentleman artist It also tells the story of his five voyages to Virginia and his role as Gov of the Lost Colony of Roanoke which preceded Capt John Smith's more successful settlement at Jamestown 20 years later Each watercolor is reproduced in color opposite its explanation supplemented by the famous de Bry engravings which spread his images throughout Europe as well as other works by contemporary and later artists The ensuing chapters place White and his work in their historical cultural and artistic context

The Place of Stone Douglas Hunter, 2017-08-04 Claimed by many to be the most frequently documented artifact in American archeology Dighton Rock is a forty ton boulder covered in petroglyphs in southern Massachusetts First noted by New England colonists in 1680 the rock's markings have been debated endlessly by scholars and everyday people alike on both sides of the Atlantic The glyphs have been erroneously assigned to an array of non Indigenous cultures Norsemen Egyptians Lost Tribes of Israel vanished Portuguese explorers and even a prince from Atlantis In this fascinating story rich in personalities and memorable characters Douglas Hunter uses Dighton Rock to reveal the long complex history of colonization American archaeology and the conceptualization of Indigenous people Hunter argues that misinterpretations of the rock's markings share common motivations and have erased Indigenous people not only from their own history but from the landscape He shows how Dighton Rock for centuries drove ideas about the original peopling of the Americas including Bering Strait migration scenarios and the identity of the Mound Builders He argues the debates over Dighton Rock have served to answer two questions Who belongs in America and to whom does America belong

examines the 1583 voyage of Sir Humphrey Gilbert to North America This was England s first attempt at colonization beyond the British Isles yet it has not been subject to thorough scholarly analysis for more than 70 years An exhaustive examination of the voyage reveals the complexity and preparedness of this and similar early modern colonizing expeditions Prominent Elizabethans assisted Gilbert by researching and investing in his expedition the Printing Revolution was critical to their plans as Gilbert s supporters traveled throughout England with promotional literature proving England s claim to North America Gilbert s experts used maps and charts to publicize and navigate while his pilots experimented with new navigating tools and practices Though he failed to establish a settlement Gilbert created a blueprint for later Stuart colonizers who achieved his vision of a British Empire in the Western Hemisphere This book clarifies the role of cartography natural science and promotional literature in Elizabethan colonization and elucidates the preparation stages of early modern colonizing voyages
