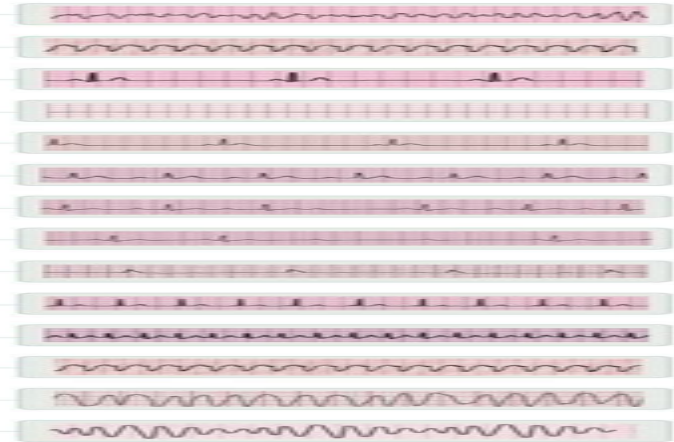
EKG Anatomy



P Wave - atrial depolarization activity in the lower right atrium
QRS Complex - ventricular depolarization activity in the lower left ventricle
T Wave - ventricular repolarization activity in the lower left ventricle
ST Segment - the interval between the end of the QRS complex and the beginning of the T wave

ECG Rhythms

- Ventricular Fibrillation** - Irregular, chaotic, and disorganized electrical activity.
- Ventricular Tachycardia** - Rapid, regular, and narrow QRS complex.
- Bradycardia** - Slow heart rate, usually less than 60 bpm.
- Asystole** - No electrical activity on EKG, if leads are all disconnected, begin CPR immediately.
- Sinus Bradycardia** - Heart rate less than 60 bpm/min.
- 1st Degree AV Block** - Prolonged PR interval, rarely.
- 2nd Degree Block Type I - Wenckebach** - Progressive PR interval prolongation until a QRS complex is dropped.
- 2nd Degree Block Type II - Mobitz** - Fixed PR interval, but some QRS complexes are dropped.
- 3rd Degree Block** - Complete dissociation of P waves and QRS complexes.
- Sinus Tachycardia** - Heart rate greater than 100 bpm/min.
- Supraventricular Tachycardia** - Rapid, regular, and narrow QRS complex.
- Polymorphic Ventricular Tachycardia** - Rapid, irregular, and wide QRS complex.
- Torsades de Pointes** - Rapid, irregular, and wide QRS complex, with a characteristic twisting of the QRS complex.



Electrical Therapy Basics



- Defibrillation** - Used to treat ventricular fibrillation (VF) and pulseless ventricular tachycardia (VT).
- Synchronized Cardioversion** - Used to treat atrial fibrillation (AF), atrial flutter (AFL), and supraventricular tachycardia (SVT).
- Transcutaneous Pacing** - Used to treat bradycardia and asystole.

Airway Management



- Adjuvants** - Used to facilitate intubation.
- Endotracheal Tube (ETT)** - Used for mechanical ventilation.
- Supraglottic Airway Device (SAD)** - Used for emergency airway management.
- Bag-Valve-Mask (BVM)** - Used for manual ventilation.

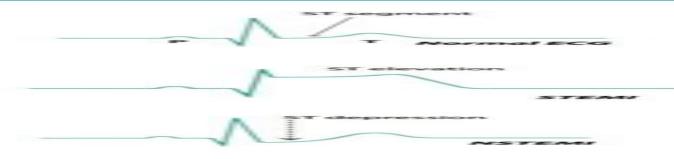
Post-Resuscitation Care



- Follow the ABCs** - Airway, Breathing, Circulation.
- Temperature** - Maintain normothermia.
- Glucose** - Maintain blood glucose levels.
- Acidosis** - Monitor and treat acidosis.
- Coagulopathy** - Monitor and treat coagulopathy.

Acute Coronary Syndromes (ACS)

- Unstable Angina** - Chest pain at rest, not relieved by nitroglycerin.
- ST Segment Elevation MI (STEMI)** - Chest pain, ST segment elevation on EKG.
- Non-ST Segment Elevation MI (NSTEMI)** - Chest pain, ST segment depression or T wave inversion on EKG.



Stroke Assessment and Treatment

- Stroke Assessment** - Use the Cincinnati Prehospital Stroke Scale (CPSS).
- Stroke Treatment** - Administer aspirin if no contraindications.
- Stroke Prevention** - Control risk factors like hypertension and diabetes.

Code Termination

- Consult with medical control before code termination.**
- Document** - Record all actions and decisions.
- Debrief** - Review the code with the team.
