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Animal Population Ecology J Dempster, 2012-12-02 *Animal Population Ecology* focuses on the interaction between the various factors that affect an animal population. Population ecology is the study of the factors that determine the abundance of species and is concerned with the identification and mode of action of those environmental factors that cause fluctuations in population size and of those which determine the extent of these fluctuations. Organized into 11 chapters, the book initially examines some of the basic ideas about animal populations and defines many of the terms used by population ecologists. Then it describes the action of the most important factors affecting population size. The interaction between these factors is demonstrated in chapters 8 and 9, wherein the results from studies of a few selected species are presented in detail. Finally, chapters 10 and 11 cover the development of generalized theories of population dynamics and their application to practical problems. With a strong focus on intensive study of animal populations in the field rather than elaborate theories, the book will be helpful to population ecologists, animal researchers, teachers, and students.

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Grassland Invertebrates Jim P. Curry, 1993-11-30

Grasslands comprise more than a quarter of the Earth's land surface. In addition to supporting a wide range of vertebrates such as domestic livestock and a variety of game species, grassland is the natural habitat for a wide range of invertebrate species, and this book considers those which occur in grassland and their impact on soil fertility and herbage growth. It describes grassland as a habitat for invertebrates, the groups which occur there, and their abundance. An extensive literature on grassland invertebrates scattered through numerous scientific journals and reports is drawn on in an attempt to develop an overview. In the opening chapter, the major grassland types are considered, and the features which influence the distribution and abundance of the invertebrates which inhabit them are discussed. Next, the major taxonomic groups are reviewed in turn, with a brief account of their biology and ecology and of their ecosystem role. Some general features of grassland invertebrate communities are then described, and the factors which influence the population densities of their constituent species are considered. Particular attention is given to the ways in which populations are influenced by management practices. The final and largest chapter deals with the various

ways in which invertebrates influence important grassland processes through ingestion of organic matter interaction with injurious species is considered with particular emphasis on the potential for achieving this through manipulating grassland management practices *Effects of Resource Distribution on Animal Plant Interactions* Mark D. Hunter, Takayuki Ohgushi, Peter W. Price, 2012-12-02 Aimed primarily at advanced graduate students and professional biologists this book explores the degree to which animal-plant interactions are determined by plant and animal variability. Many of the patterns seen in natural communities appear to result from cascading effects up as well as down the trophic system. Variability among primary producers can influence animal and plant population quality and dynamics, community structure and the evolution of animal-plant interactions.

Principles of Ecology Rory Putman, 2012-12-06 As Ecology teachers ourselves we have become increasingly aware of the lack of a single comprehensive textbook of Ecology which we can recommend unreservedly to our students. While general review texts are readily available in other fields, recent publications in Ecology have tended for the most part to be small specialised works on single aspects of the subject. Such general texts as are available are often rather too detailed and in addition tend to be somewhat biased towards one aspect of the discipline or another and are thus not truly balanced syntheses of current knowledge. Ecology is in addition a rapidly developing subject; new information is being gathered all the time on a variety of key questions; new approaches and techniques open up whole new areas of research and establish new principles. Already things have changed radically since the early 70s and we feel there is a need for an up to date student text that will include some of this newer material. We have tried therefore to create a text that will review all the major principles and tenets within the whole field of Ecology, presenting the generally accepted theories and fundamentals and reviewing carefully the evidence on which such principles have been founded. While recent developments in ecological thought are emphasised we hope that these will not dominate the material to the extent where the older established principles are ignored or overlooked.
