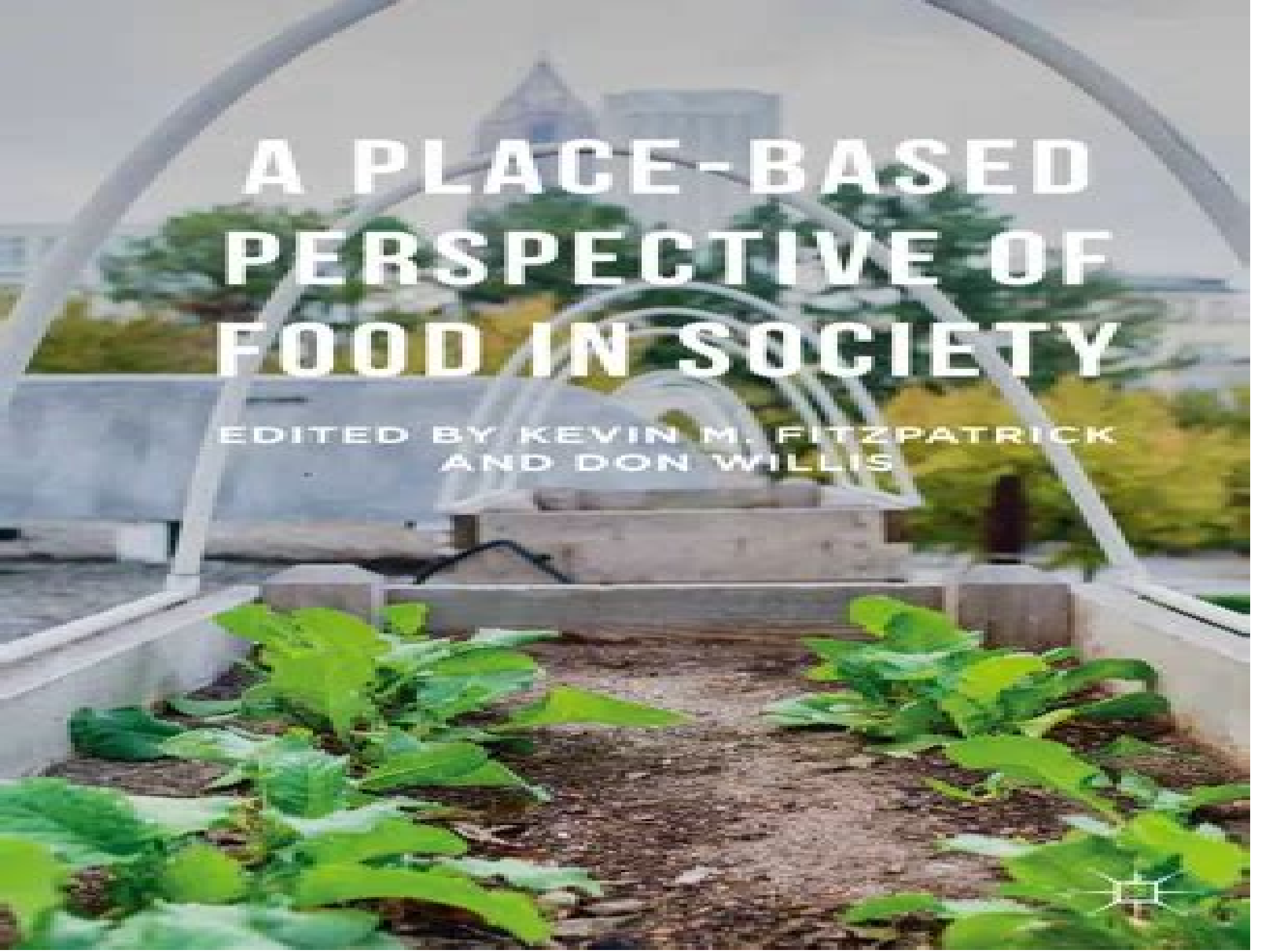

Firth, 2023-11-15 After Hurricane Katrina in 2005 many high profile chefs in New Orleans pledged to help their city rebound from the flooding Several formed their own charitable organizations including the John Besh Foundation to help revitalize the region and its restaurant scene A year and a half after the disaster when the total number of open restaurants eclipsed the pre Katrina count it was embraced as a sign that the city itself had survived and these chefs arguably became the de facto heroes of the city s recovery Meanwhile food justice organizations tried to tap into the city s legendary food culture to fundraise marketing high end dining events that centered these celebrity chefs Jeanne K Firth documents the growth of celebrity humanitarianism viewing the phenomenon through the lens of feminist ethnography to understand how elite philanthropy is raced classed and gendered Firth finds that cultures of sexism in the restaurant industry also infuse chef led philanthropic initiatives As she examines this particular flavor of elite celebrity based philanthropy Firth illuminates the troubled relationships between consumerism food justice movements and public private partnerships in development and humanitarian aid *Food for the Future* John Brueggemann, 2023-07-03 Food for the Future Stories from the Alternative Agro food Movement is about different foods the stories they contain and most of all the people in the stories John Brueggemann interviewed dozens of farmers chefs non profit managers consumers teachers and healthcare providers He argues that their individual stories point towards larger patterns that have shaped the alternative agro food movement and that other factors including the environmental movement farms lifestyle movements and consumers have all played a crucial role in its rise The author concludes that the alternative agro food movement is providing a countervailing force relative to mainstream market culture and that instead of efficiency profit consumption individualism and short term thinking the

alternative agro food movement emphasizes meaning need creation community and long term thinking *Global Sustainable Practices in Gastronomic Tourism* Rana, Varinder Singh, Raina, Ashish, Bathla, Gaurav, 2024-12-02 Developing sustainable practices in gastronomic tourism is essential for creating a responsible and impactful travel experience As travelers become conscious of their environmental and social impact the culinary tourism sector prioritizes sustainability at every stage This includes promoting local ingredients supporting small scale producers and minimizing food waste while also celebrating cultural heritage through authentic culinary experiences Gastronomic tourism enhances the visitor experience while contributing to the preservation of local ecosystems and communities Further research into gastronomic tourism is necessary to promote multi stakeholder cooperation between local communities companies NGOs and governments for improved sustainability of culinary tourism *Global Sustainable Practices in Gastronomic Tourism* explores sustainability principles in relation to culinary tourism including its effects on the environment society and economy It examines how sustainable tourism practices incorporate gastronomic heritage emphasizing the value of maintaining regional food systems and culinary customs This book covers topics such as conservation and preservation social media and waste management and is a useful resource for hospitality and tourism professionals economists environmental scientists marketers business owners academicians and researchers *Elite Authenticity* Gwynne Mapes, 2021 Food plays a central role in the production of culture and is likewise a powerful resource for the representation and organization of social order Status is asserted or contested through both the materiality of food its substance its raw economics and its manufacture or preparation and through its discursivity its marketing staging and the way it is depicted and discussed This intersection of materiality and discursivity makes food an ideal site for examining the place of language in contemporary class formations and for engaging cutting edge debates in sociolinguistics on language materiality In *Elite Authenticity* Gwynne Mapes integrates theories of mediatization materiality and authenticity in order to explore the discursive production of elite status and class inequality in food discourse Relying on a range of methodological approaches Mapes examines restaurant reviews and articles published in the New York Times food section a collection of Instagram posts from nytfood ethnographically informed fieldwork in four renowned Brooklyn NY restaurants and a recorded dinner conversation with six food enthusiasts Across these varied genres of data she demonstrates how a discourse of elite authenticity represents a particular surfacing of rhetorical maneuvers in which distinction is orchestrated avowed disavowed and circulated *Elite Authenticity* takes a multimodal critical discourse analysis approach drawing on theories from linguistics food and cultural studies anthropology sociology and philosophy Its presentation and analysis of aural visual spatial material and embodied discourse will be of interest to scholars and students of communication studies critical discourse studies sociolinguistics linguistic anthropology and cultural geography
