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Beyond the World Bank Agenda Howard Stein, 2008-09-15 Despite massive investment of money and research aimed at ameliorating third world poverty the development strategies of the international financial institutions over the past few decades have been a profound failure Under the tutelage of the World Bank developing countries have experienced lower growth and rising inequality compared to previous periods In *Beyond the World Bank Agenda* Howard Stein argues that the controversial institution is plagued by a myopic neoclassical mindset that wrongly focuses on individual rationality and downplays the social and political contexts that can either facilitate or impede development Drawing on the examples of Africa Asia Latin America and transitional European economies this revolutionary volume proposes an alternative vision of institutional development with chapter length applications to finance state formation and health care to provide a holistic contextualized solution to the problems of developing nations *Beyond the World Bank Agenda* will be essential reading for anyone concerned with forging a new strategy for sustainable development

Who Matters at the World Bank? Kim Moloney, 2022 *Who Matters at the World Bank* explores who matters in a 32 year history 1980 2012 of policy change within the World Bank's public sector management and public sector governance agenda and is anchored within the public administration discipline and its understanding of bureaucracy bureaucratic politics and stakeholder influences In response to constructivist scholars concerns about politics and the organizational culture of international civil servants within international organizations Kim Moloney uses stakeholder theory and a bureaucratic politics approach to suggest the normality of politics policy debate and policy evolution The book also highlights how for 21 of those 32 years it was not external stakeholders but the international civil servants of the World Bank who most influenced led developed and institutionalized this sector's agenda In so doing the book explains how one sector of the Bank's work rose against the odds from being included in just under 3% of approved projects in 1980 to 73% of all projects approved between 1991 and 2012

The World Bank and Transferring Development Adrian Robert Bazbauers, 2017-08-20 This book analyses the World Bank's provision of technical assistance from 1946 to the present day It argues that the relational dynamics between technical assistance provider and recipient affects the legitimacy of policy norms travelling from the international to the domestic Beginning from the constructivist position that development is a social construct the author contends that successful policy movement via technical assistance depends on the recipient's perception of the validity of policy reforms with perception being influenced by the way those ideas and practices are presented packaged and transferred In advancing this argument Bazbauers analyses four pillars of World Bank technical assistance technical assistance components advisory services incorporated within lending operations stand alone technical assistance projects projects designed to solely deliver technical assistance survey missions activities involved in measuring the development status of developing countries and training institutes the courses of the Economic Development Institute and World Bank Institute

Gendered Insecurities,

Health and Development in Africa Howard Stein, Amal Hassan Fadlalla, 2012 The concept of security has often narrowly focused on issues surrounding the protection of national borders from outside threats However a richer idea of human security has become increasingly important in the past decade or so The aim is to incorporate various dimensions of the downside risks affecting the generalized well being or dignity of people Despite this rising prominence the discourses surrounding human security have neglected to address the topic of gender particularly how issues of poverty and underdevelopment impact women s and men s experiences and strategies differently Since its introduction in the 1994 UNDP Human Development report the idea of human security has become increasingly influential among academics and international development practitioners However gendered dimensions of human security have not attracted enough attention despite their vital importance Women are disproportionately more vulnerable to disease and other forms of human insecurity due to differences in entitlement empowerment and an array of other ecological and socio economic factors These gendered insecurities are inextricably linked to poverty and as a result the feminization of poverty is a growing phenomenon worldwide The contributors to this volume rely on a gender focused analysis to consider a number of issues central to human security and development in Africa including food security environmental health risks discrimination within judicial and legal systems gendered aspects of HIV AIDS transmission and treatment technologies neoliberalism and poverty alleviation strategies and conflict and women s political activism The gender focus of this volume points to the importance of power relationships and policy variability underlying human insecurities in the African context The insights of this book offer the potential for an improved human security framework one that embraces a more complex and context specific analysis of the issues of risk and vulnerability therefore expanding the capacities of the human security framework to safeguard the livelihoods of the most vulnerable populations
