Annelids

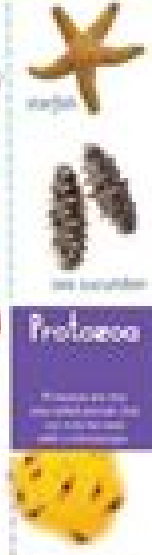
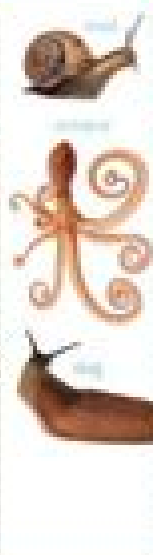
Annelids have a long, segmented body, a head, a foot, and a mantle. They breathe through their gills.
