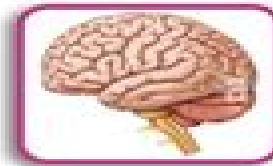

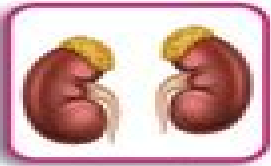
Brain weight



Damage to cell membranes



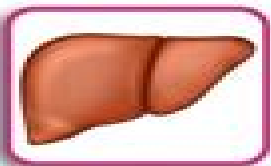
Basal metabolic rate



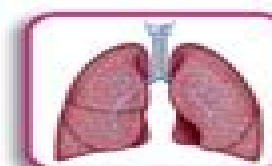
Loss of renal mass
