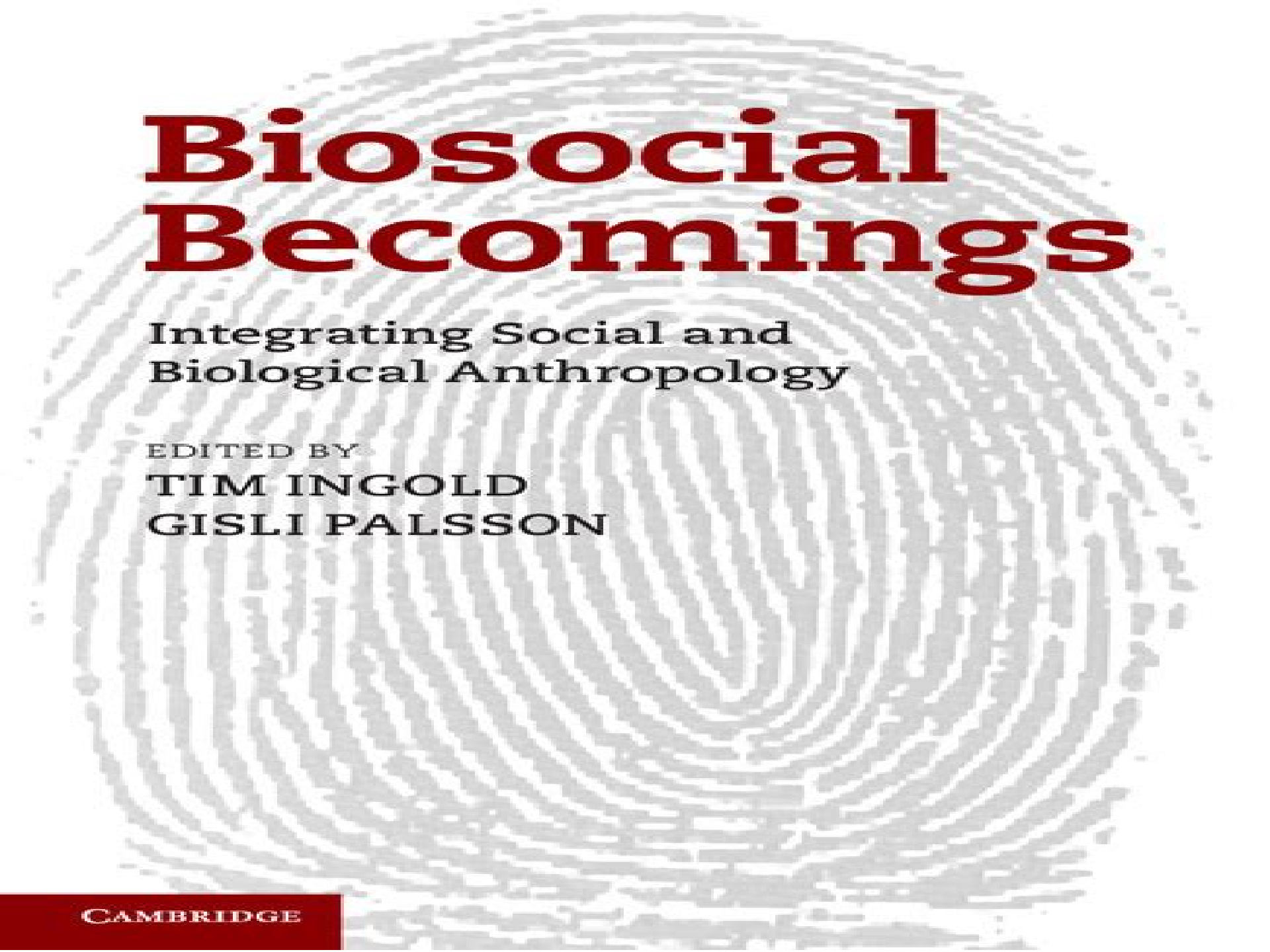

Palkovich, 2024-05-11 This volume introduces the place of Arroyo Hondo Pueblo in our understanding of Southwestern Archaeology in the Northern Rio Grande The author discusses the reanalysis of the skeletal and mortuary remains that draws on a half century of research since the original excavations were conducted by the School of American Research from 1970 1974 under the direction of Douglas W Schwartz The volume offers a close read of the mortuary evidence at Arroyo Hondo Pueblo and integrates ideas about corn as a central feature of Tewa cosmology with this crop as the paramount dietary staple The author discusses the health consequences of dry farming subsistence and present evidence for malnutrition and other dietary issues and finally describes the impact of malnutrition and other maladies on the everyday lives of Arroyo Hondo s villagers This volume is for readers interested in bioarchaeology paleopathology and Southwestern Archaeology

Sea Cucumber Stories Paula Uimonen, 2025-10-29 Sea Cucumber Stories explores multispecies entanglements and ocean worldings from a sea cucumber perspective Drawing on environmental multispecies and ocean anthropology it enlists the sea cucumber to tell stories of how and why the ocean and its creatures matter to life on our blue planet The chapters draw on multisited multimodal and multisensory fieldwork in Tanzania where the sea cucumber is undergoing interesting transformations from an ocean creature created by God to a commodity in the global seafood market farmed for export to China While breaking new ground in multispecies anthropology this creative book builds on the author s earlier work in digital and literary anthropology Sea cucumber stories are told from an imaginary as well as a scholarly perspective The sea cucumber is treated as a fellow creature to draw attention to the wonders of multispecies undersea worlds and the troubles of human exploitation of what is perceived as a marine resource

Thibault, 2023-07-28 The two inter linked volumes in this series are dedicated to the development of analysis and theorisation of learning and teaching in higher education The two volumes focus on the multi scalar ecological inter connectedness of learners with teachers with artefacts with cultural patterns and resources with places with social activities and practices with social institutions with time and temporality and with technologies Learning reflects inter individual dynamics that are shaped by biology and culture Against prevailing orthodoxies that view learning in higher education in

Theological Ethics through a Multispecies Lens Celia E. Deane-Drummond, 2019-11-05 There are two driving questions informing this book The first is where does our moral life come from It presupposes that considering morality broadly is inadequate Instead different aspects need to be teased apart It is not sufficient to assume that different virtues are bolted onto a vicious animality red in tooth and claw Nature and culture have interlaced histories By weaving in evolutionary theories and debates on the evolution of compassion justice and wisdom it shows a richer account of who we are as moral agents The second driving question concerns our relationships with animals Deane Drummond argues for a complex community based multispecies approach Hence rather than extending rights a more radical approach is a holistic multispecies framework for moral action This need not weaken individual responsibility She intends not to develop a manual of practice but rather to build towards an alternative philosophically informed approach to theological ethics including animal ethics The theological thread weaving through this account is wisdom Wisdom has many different levels and in the broadest sense is connected with the flow of life understood in its interconnectedness and sociality It is profoundly theological and practical In naming the project the evolution of wisdom Deane Drummond makes a statement about where wisdom may have come from and its future orientation But justice compassion and conscience are not far behind especially in so far as they are relevant to both individual decision making and institutions
