This book would be beneficial for anyone who is or will be working with adults with learning disabilities. The information is comprehensive and understandable. The illustrative use of anecdotal accounts of people with learning disabilities is especially beneficial. ■

ADHD WITH COMORBID DISORDERS: CLINICAL ASSESSMENT AND MANAGEMENT

IN *ADHD WITH COMORBID DISORDERS: CLINICAL ASSESSMENT and Management*, Pliszka, Carlson, and Swanson provide practitioners with (a) a working knowledge of research on children displaying both attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and other comorbid psychiatric conditions, (b) state-of-the-art knowledge of the complex psychopharmacological interventions that may serve these children, and (c) familiarity with appropriate psychosocial treatments for a wide variety of disruptive and emotional behaviors. The introduction describes the authors' goals and target audience, defines comorbidity, and discusses diagnostic challenges. Pitfalls in the study of comorbidity and differences in the approaches taken by medical and behavioral experts are also described.

The second section comprises chapters on psychiatric assessment and behavioral assessment, and the third section presents chapters on psychopharmacological interventions and behavioral interventions. The fourth section, "Comorbid Conditions," consists of eight chapters that discuss eight distinct comorbidities: disruptive behavior disorders and substance abuse, neurological disorders, affective disorders, anxiety disorders, mental retardation and pervasive developmental disorders, medical disorders, learning disorders, and tic and obsessive-compulsive disorders.

Each chapter clearly articulates the issues necessary for differential as well as concurrent diagnosis, and provides a current, well-detailed review of empirical research on relevant psychopharmacological treatments. The sections are

well organized, well written, and of particular value to the physician charged with selecting appropriate medications. Types of studies and decision-making diagrams are conveniently tabulated or illustrated, and whether medication trials were conducted within or without behavioral interventions is clearly denoted. These sections contain an unusual number of typographical and editing oversights, however.

A second and more substantial concern about the book is the risk that the reader might over generalize the findings in the text to populations that resemble but are not equivalent with the diagnostic groups described. Although Pliszka et al. emphasize the critical importance of accurate diagnosis prior to prescribing treatment, they likewise acknowledge the plethora of clinical judgments that deviate from strict diagnostic criteria in actual practice. This qualification is critical because the authors' strong interpretations regarding medical causality are based on rigorous and careful diagnosis. Patients who display some features characteristic of the conditions under review but fail to meet the most stringent criteria may not benefit to the same degree from the medicinal interventions described.

Although the documentation of research on medicinal treatments is accurate and commendable, other details of the authors' implicit views on biocausality would be overstated if generalized to the majority of ADHD cases. In detailing proper diagnostic procedures, the authors warn of the difficulties inherent in interpreting and weighing information from multiple and possibly disagreeing informants. The risk herein is that readers unfamiliar with these issues could misinterpret the generality of the findings discussed to cases requiring more refined diagnostic efforts. One illustration of this difficulty may be seen in the consideration of family studies as evidence of genetic determination. Whether ADHD and comorbid conditions run in families or co-segregate is important in making the case that known physiological mechanisms justify the use of pharmacological interventions in keeping with their use elsewhere in psychiatric practice. If depression runs in the families of children with ADHD who also exhibit depressive symptoms, then a stronger case is made for the concurrent diagnosis and treatment of depression in those children. However, for most disruptive children, evaluation of particular environmental events that influence the severity of symptoms are more immediately critical to effective diagnosis and treatment than examinations of broader familial mental health issues.

Although putative links between genetics and disease symptoms are important in justifying the view that children with ADHD may potentially be concurrently encumbered by the entire spectrum of psychiatric conditions, readers should be cautioned that most contemporary theorizing on health and wellness utilizes a biopsychosocial model, under which a complex interplay of biological, psychological, and sociological events is understood to collectively affect health. This multivariate, interactive view is not clearly articulated throughout the book, and it is therefore incumbent on the
