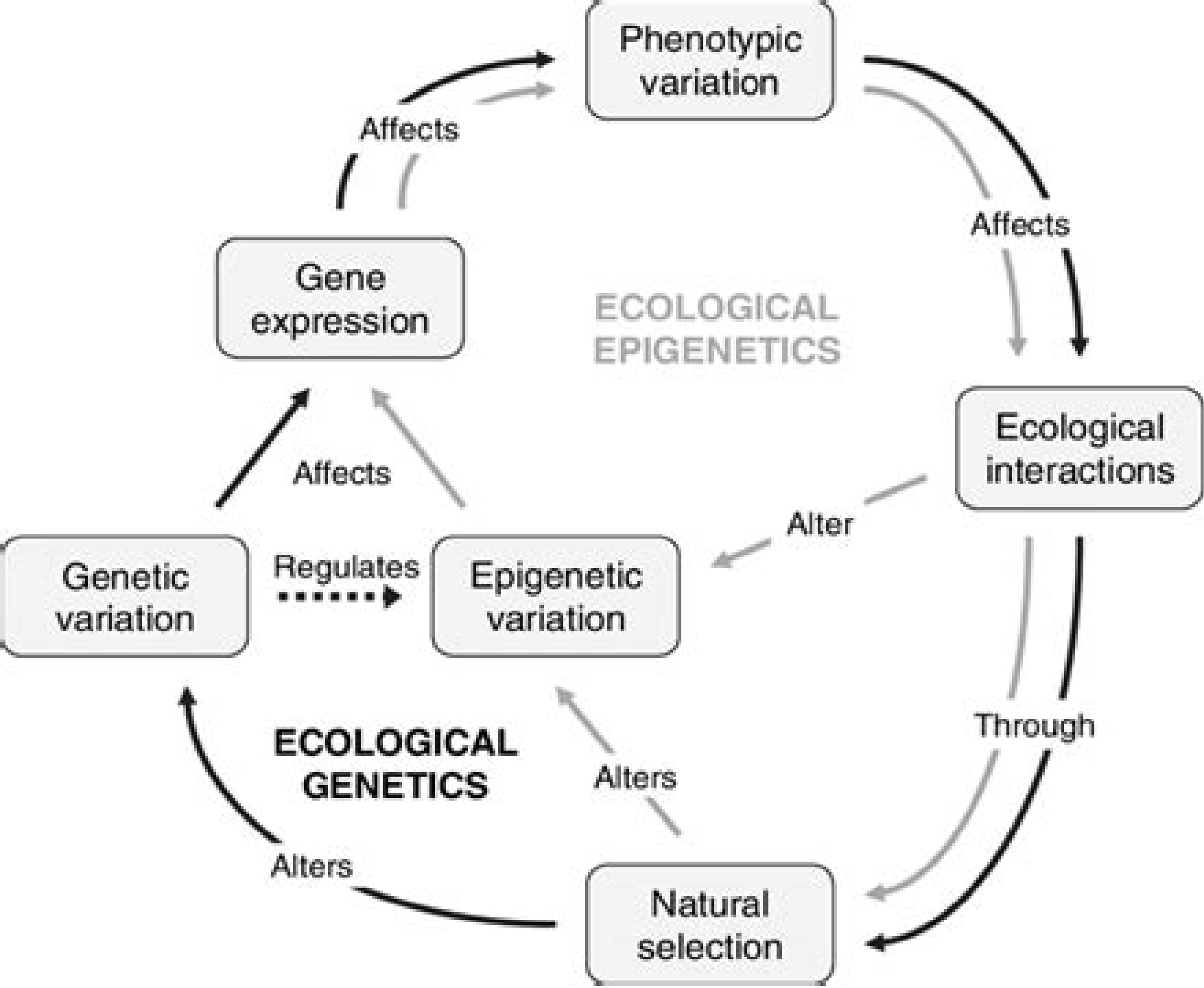

The approach also emphasizes learning by doing, which in this case means solving numerical or conceptual problems. The rationale behind this is that the use of concepts in problem solving leads to deeper understanding and longer knowledge retention. This accessible introductory textbook is aimed principally at students of various levels and abilities, from senior undergraduate to postgraduate, as well as practising scientists in the fields of population genetics, ecology, evolutionary biology, computational biology, bioinformatics, biostatistics, physics, and mathematics.
