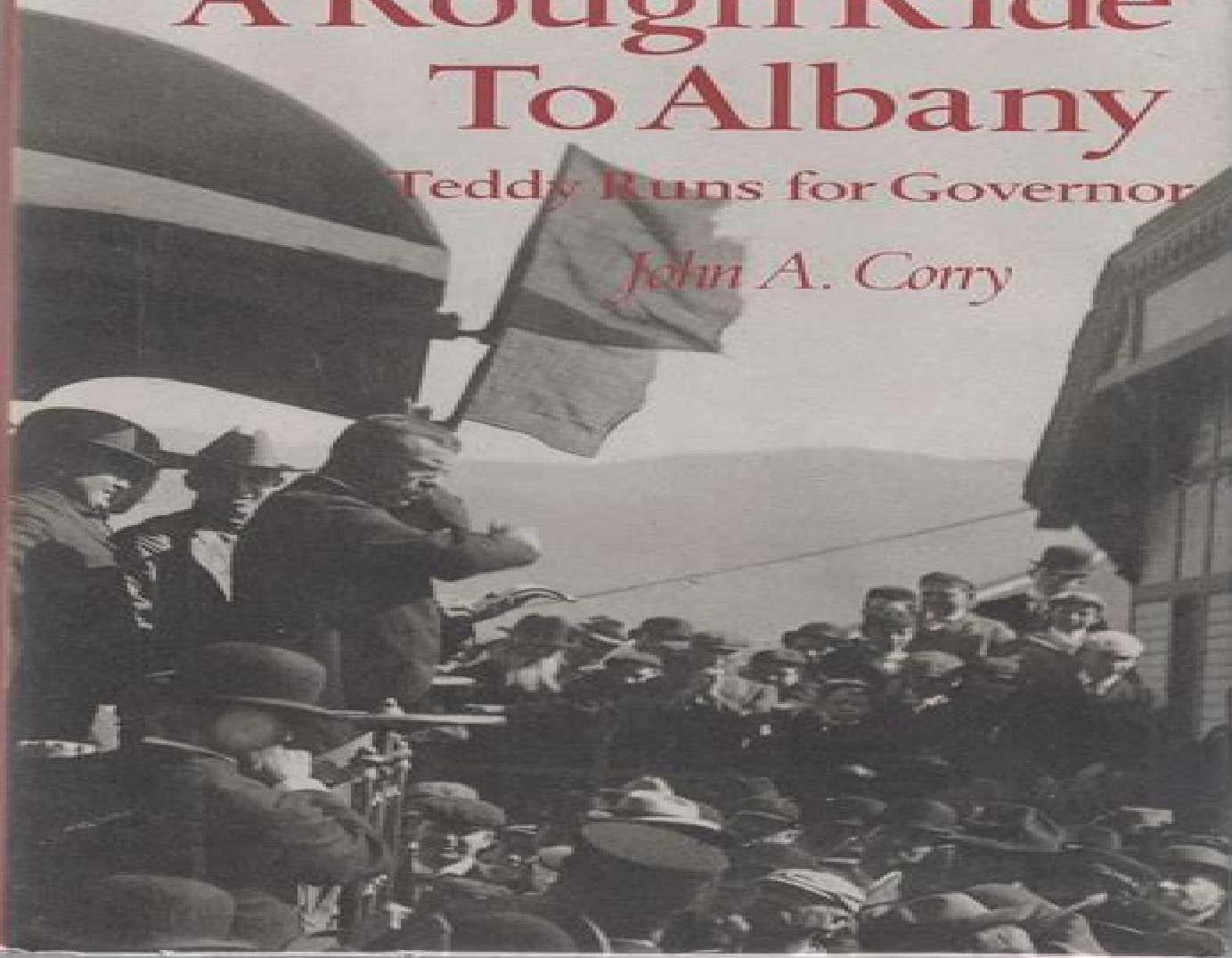

Theodore Roosevelt and the Art of American Power William R. Nester, 2019-02-28 Theodore Roosevelt is an American icon his face carved in granite alongside those of Washington Jefferson and Lincoln on Mt Rushmore He is the only American awarded both the Medal of Honor and Nobel Peace Prize As president he pushed through a stubborn Congress to breakup corporate monopolies strangling the economy impose health standards on the food and drug industries and conserve America's natural heritage including the Grand Canyon and Redwood forest He was a brilliant diplomat who ended a war between Japan and Russia and prevented a war between Germany and France He engineered independence for the province of Panama from Columbia then signed a treaty with the new country that entitled the United States to build run and defend a Panama canal He crusaded for progressive reforms as a New York assemblyman U S civil service commissioner New York City police commissioner and New York governor He led scientific expeditions across East Africa's savanna and Brazil's rainforest During the war with Spain he raised a cavalry regiment and led his Rough Riders to a
