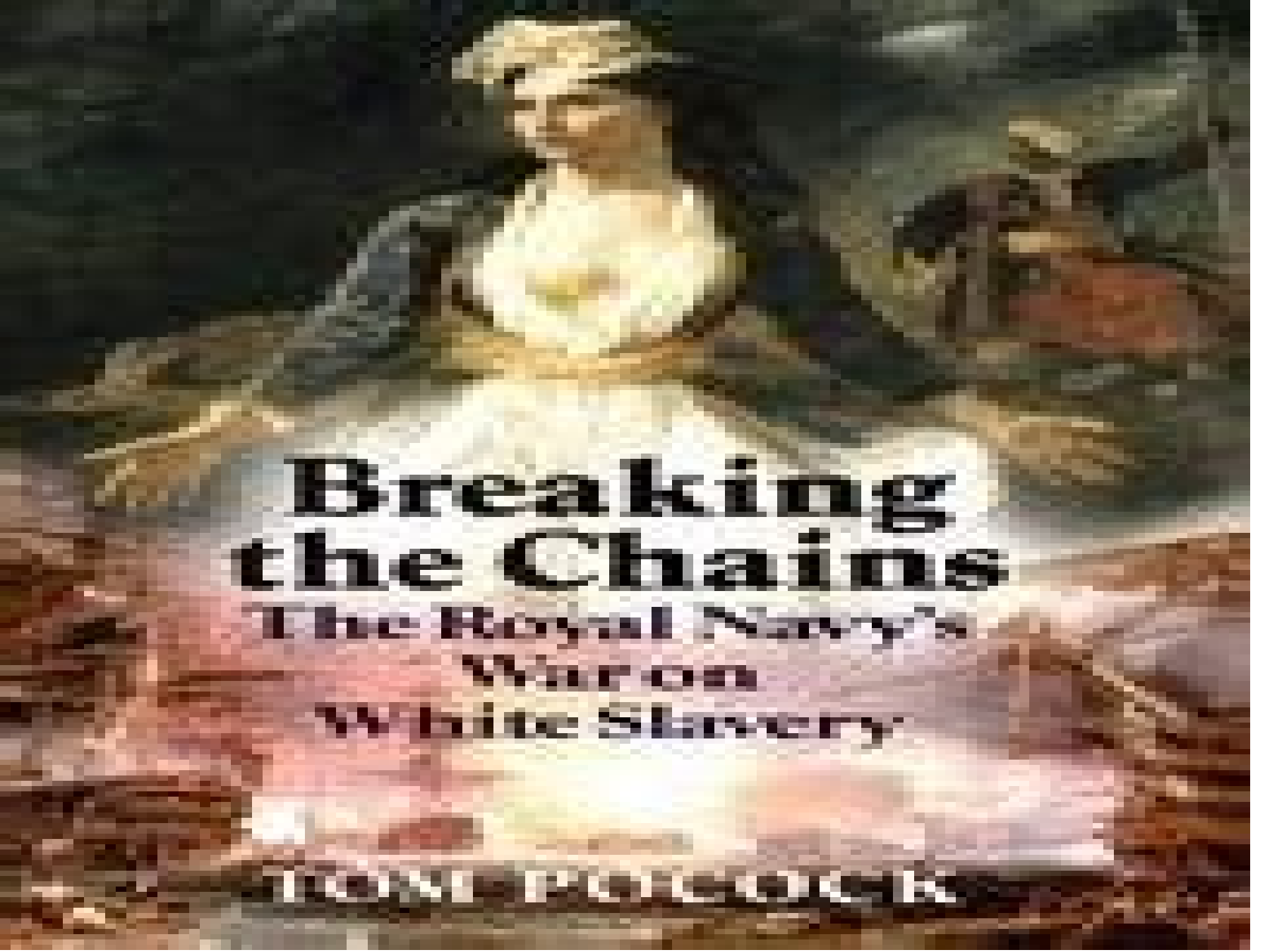

Jamieson, 2013-02-15 The escalation of piracy in the waters east and south of Somalia has led commentators to call the area the new Barbary but the Somali pirates cannot compare to the three hundred years of terror supplied by the Barbary corsairs in the Mediterranean and beyond From 1500 to 1800 Muslim pirates from the Barbary Coast of North Africa captured and enslaved more than a million Christians *Lords of the Sea* relates the history of these pirates examining their dramatic impact as the maritime vanguard of the Ottoman Empire in the early 1500s through their breaking from Ottoman control in the early seventeenth century Alan Jamieson explores how the corsairs rose to the apogee of their powers during this period extending their activities from the Mediterranean into the Atlantic and venturing as far as England Ireland and Iceland Serving as a vital component of the main Ottoman fleet the Barbary pirates also conducted independent raids of Christian ships and territory While their activities declined after 1700 Jamieson reveals that it was only in the early nineteenth century that Europe and the United States finally curtailed the Barbary menace a fight that culminated in the French conquest of Algiers in 1830 A welcome addition to military history *Lords of the Sea* is an engrossing tale of exploration slavery and conquest **Captives and Corsairs** Gillian Weiss, 2011-03-11 *Captives and Corsairs* uncovers a forgotten story in the history of relations between the West and Islam three centuries of Muslim corsair raids on French ships and shores and the resulting captivity of tens of thousands of French subjects and citizens in North Africa Through an analysis of archival materials writings and images produced by contemporaries the book fundamentally revises our picture of France s emergence as a nation and a colonial power presenting the Mediterranean as an essential vantage point for studying the rise of France It reveals how efforts to liberate slaves from North Africa shaped France s perceptions of the Muslim world and of their own Frenchness From around 1550 to 1830 freeing these captives evolved from an expression of Christian charity to a method of state building and eventually to a rationale for imperial expansion *Captives and Corsairs* thus advances new arguments about the fluid nature of slavery and firmly links captive redemption to state formation and in turn to the still vital ideology of liberatory conquest **Slavery, Diplomacy and Empire** Keith Hamilton, 2013-03-04 Throughout the nineteenth century British governments engaged in a global campaign against the slave trade They sought through coercion and diplomacy to suppress the trade on the high seas and in Africa and Asia This collection of essays examines the role played by individuals and institutions in the diplomacy of suppression Commander Stephen Taylor, 2012-10-08 Nobody describes a naval battle better than Taylor a flawless demonstration of the biographer s craft Jan Morris The Guardian Edward Pellew captain of the legendary *Indefatigable* was quite simply the greatest British frigate captain in the age of sail Left fatherless at age eight with a penniless mother and five siblings Pellew fought his way from the very bottom of the navy to fleet command Victories and eye catching feats won him a public following Yet he had a gift for antagonizing

Race Traffic Gunther Peck, 2024-12-10 Fantasies of white slavery and the narratives of victimhood they spawn form the foundation of racist ideology They also obscure the lived experience of trafficked servants and sailors in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries Gunther Peck moves deftly between the Atlantic and Mediterranean worlds to discover where and when people with light skin color came to see themselves as white Separating fact from fiction and paying close attention to the ideological work each performs Peck shows how laboring women and men leveraged their newfound whiteness to secure economic opportunity and political power Peck argues that whiteness emerged not as a claim of racial superiority but as a byproduct of wide ranging and rancorous public debate over trafficking and enslavement Even as whiteness became a legal category that signaled privilege trafficking and race remained

tightly interwoven Those advocating for the value of whiteness invoked emotionally freighted victimhood claiming that so called white slavery was a crime whose costs far exceeded those associated with the enslavement of African peoples across the Americas Peck helps us understand the chilling history that produced the racist ideology that still poisons our politics in the present day **Market and Violence** Heide Gerstenberger, 2022-10-10 Winner of the Deutscher Memorial Prize 2023 Despite their many disagreements when it comes to the subject of capitalism Marxist and market liberal approaches seem to agree about one thing the economic structures of capitalist market society have made direct violence against the person not only superfluous but economically counterproductive Heide Gerstenberger's *Market and Violence* does not contest the thesis that there has been in many places a decline in the use of violence in the pursuit of profit but it demolishes the assumption that this can be put down to the evolution of economic rationality By means of a deep engagement with the concrete historical reality of capitalist economies Gerstenberger establishes that wherever capitalism has been tamed this has been achieved only by a combination of energetic social contestation and political intervention First published in German in 2018 the present English language edition makes a sweeping history of capitalist violence by one of the preeminent theorists of capitalist society working today available to a wider readership **The Literary Review** ,2006

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
