Assessing and Restoring Natural Resources In Post-Conflict Peacebuilding David Jensen, Stephen Loneragan, 2013-02-15 When a country emerges from violent conflict the management of the environment and natural resources has important implications for short term peacebuilding and long term stability particularly if natural resources were a factor in the conflict play a major role in the national economy or broadly support livelihoods Only recently however have the assessment harnessing and restoration of the natural resource base become essential components of postconflict peacebuilding This book by thirty five authors examines the experiences of more than twenty countries and territories in assessing post conflict environmental damage and natural resource degradation and their implications for human health livelihoods and security The book also illustrates how an understanding of both the risks and opportunities associated with natural resources can help decision makers manage natural resources in ways that create jobs sustain livelihoods and contribute to economic recovery and reconciliation without creating new grievances or significant environmental degradation Finally the book offers lessons from the remediation of environmental hot spots restoration of damaged ecosystems and reconstruction of the environmental services and infrastructure necessary for a sustainable peace Assessing and Restoring Natural Resources in Post Conflict Peacebuilding is part of a global initiative to identify and analyze lessons in post conflict peacebuilding and natural resource management The project has generated six books of case studies and analyses with contributions by practitioners policy makers and researchers Other books address highvalue resources land water livelihoods and governance

Governance, Natural Resources and Post-Conflict Peacebuilding Carl Bruch, Carroll Muffett, Sandra Nichols, 2016-04-07 When the guns are silenced those who have survived armed conflict need food water shelter the means to earn a living and the promise of safety and a return to civil order Meeting these needs while sustaining peace requires more than simply having governmental structures in place it requires good governance Natural resources are essential to sustaining people and peace in post conflict countries but governance failures often jeopardize such efforts This book examines the theory practice and often surprising realities of post conflict governance natural resource management and peacebuilding in fifty conflict affected countries and territories It includes thirty nine chapters written by more than seventy researchers diplomats military personnel and practitioners from governmental intergovernmental and nongovernmental organizations The book highlights the mutually reinforcing relationship between natural resource management and good governance Natural resource management is crucial to rebuilding governance and the rule of law combating corruption improving transparency and accountability engaging disenfranchised populations and building confidence after conflict At the same time good governance is essential for ensuring that natural resource management can meet immediate needs for post conflict stability and development while simultaneously laying the foundation for a sustainable peace Drawing on analyses of the close relationship between governance and natural resource management the

scholars of Anthropology Geography Development Studies and International Relations to provide a series of critical analyses of mainstream thinking on the climate security nexus It shows how policy discourse on climate conflict consistently misrepresents the causes of violence especially by obscuring its core political dimensions It demonstrates that quantitative research provides a flawed basis for understanding climate conflict linkages It argues that climate security discourse is in hoc with a range of questionable military authoritarian and developmental agendas And it reveals that the greening of global capitalism is already having violent consequences across the global South Climate change the book argues does indeed have serious conflict and security implications but these are quite different from how they are usually imagined This book was published as a special issue of Geopolitics
