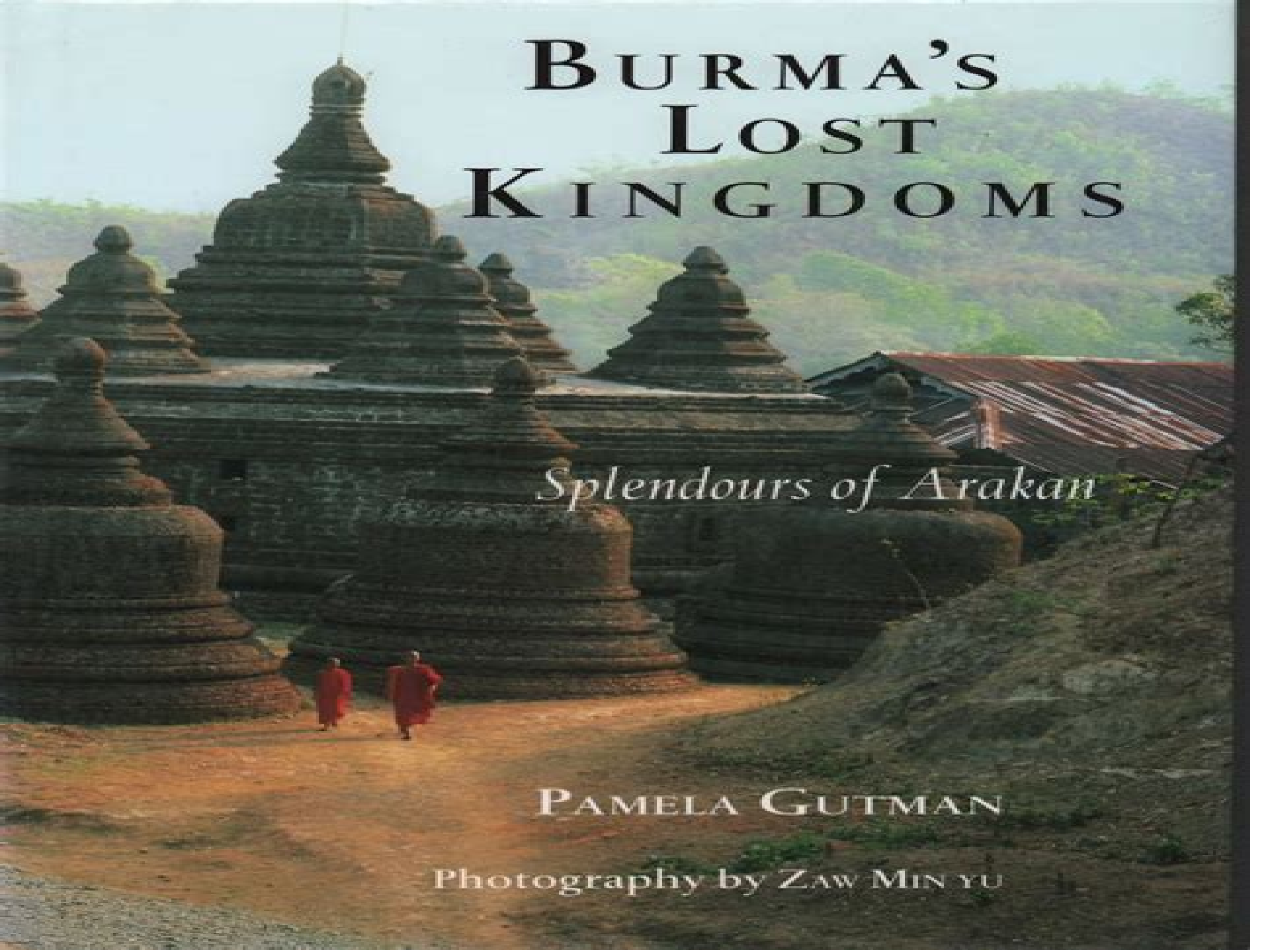

Burma's Lost Kingdoms Pamela Gutman, 2001 This thorough introduction to the history art and culture of Arakan an ancient state located in the northeast corner of Burma explains and illustrates how Southeast Asia from the beginning of the first millennium absorbed and reinterpreted the influences of many cultures It is written by a noted scholar who visited the area over many years while conducting research for her doctoral thesis on Arakan Off the Bay of Bengal in the northwest corner of Burma lie the splendid capital cities of ancient Arakan Dhanyaawadi Vesali and Mrauk U Myohaung being the largest Mentioned in Ptolemy's Geographia 2nd century Arakan was from earliest times a cosmopolitan state with a vigorous and mixed culture Indian Brahmins conducted the royal ceremonies Buddhist monks spread their teachings traders came and went and artists and architects used Indian models for inspiration Through Buddhism Arakan came into contact with other remote countries including Sri Lanka Nepal Tibet and China To the east were the many early empires of Southeast Asia Burman Siamese and Khmer while later came influences from the Islamic courts of Bengal and Delhi This is the first comprehensive study on the history art and culture of Arakan It also serves as an excellent introduction to the hitherto almost unknown bronze and stone art of Arakan [Vaishali and the Indianization of Arakan](#) Noel F. Chapman, 2013-07-31 The ancient ruins of Southeast Asia have long sparked curiosity and romance in the world's imagination They appear in accounts of nineteenth century French explorers as props for Indiana Jones adventures and more recently as the scene of Lady Lara Croft's fantastical battle with the forces of evil They have been featured in National Geographic magazine and serve as backdrops for popular television travel and reality shows Now William Chapman's expansive new study explores the varied roles these monumental remains have played in the histories of Southeast Asia's modern nations Based on more than fifteen years of travel research and visits to hundreds of ancient sites A Heritage of Ruins shows the close connection between ruins conservation and both colonialism and nation building It also demonstrates the profound impact of European derived ideas of historic and aesthetic significance on ancient ruins and how these continue to color the management and presentation of sites in Southeast Asia today Angkor Pagan Bagan Borobudur and Ayutthaya lie at the center of this cultural and architectural tour but less visited sites including Laos's stunning Vat Phu the small temple platforms of Malaysia's Lembah Bujang Valley the candi of the Dieng Plateau in Java and the ruins of Mingun in Burma and Wiang Kum Kam near Chiang Mai in northern Thailand are also discussed All share a relative isolation from modern urban centers of population sitting in park like settings serving as objects of tourism and as lynchpins for local and even national economies Chapman argues that these sites also remain important to surrounding residents both as a means of income and as continuing sources of spiritual meaning He examines the complexities of heritage efforts in the context of present day expectations by focusing on the roles of both outside and indigenous experts in conservation and management and on attempts by local populations to reclaim

their patrimony and play a larger role in protection and interpretation Tracing the history of interventions aimed at halting time s decay Chapman provides a chronicle of conservation efforts over a century and a half highlighting the significant part foreign expertise has played in the region and the ways that national programs have in recent years begun to break from earlier models The book ends with suggestions for how Southeast Asian managers and officials might best protect their incomparable heritage of art and architecture and how this legacy might be preserved for future generations **Buddhist**

The Mists of Rāmañña Michael A. Myanmar's Enemy Within Francis Wade, 2017-08-15 For decades Myanmar has been portrayed as a case of good citizen versus bad regime men in jackboots maintaining a suffocating rule over a majority Buddhist population beholden to the ideals of non violence and tolerance But in recent years this narrative has been upended In June 2012 violence between Buddhists and Muslims erupted in western Myanmar pointing to a growing divide between religious communities that before had received little attention from the outside world Attacks on Muslims soon spread across the country leaving hundreds dead entire neighbourhoods turned to rubble and tens of thousands of Muslims confined to internment camps This violence breaking out amid the passage to democracy was spurred on by monks pro democracy activists and even politicians In this gripping and deeply reported account Francis Wade explores how the manipulation of identities by an anxious ruling elite has laid the foundations for mass violence and how in Myanmar s case some of the most respected and articulate voices for
